- How is each section ordered? And is that ok?
- Do the counts match?
- Where do items link to?
- Does the data make sense?
- How might someone interpret each section?
- What happens on hover over?
- What happens to the displayed data when the page is refreshed? Does anything change?
- Does a new item add to the count of something (on refresh)?

⚠ Looks like there's a rogue "collection" activity included on the profile page yet not in the latest activities page. The rest of the order of activities is a match between the profile page and dedicated activities page.

💡 I wonder if we don't need to display the last five community star reasons. Given this information appears in the Activity section and is formatted in a way that's clickable and engaging I think it's ok to just display star information here in this activity section. I appreciate though that in some cases that there might not always be stars in recent activity. Instead we could just display the Stars title and count i.e.

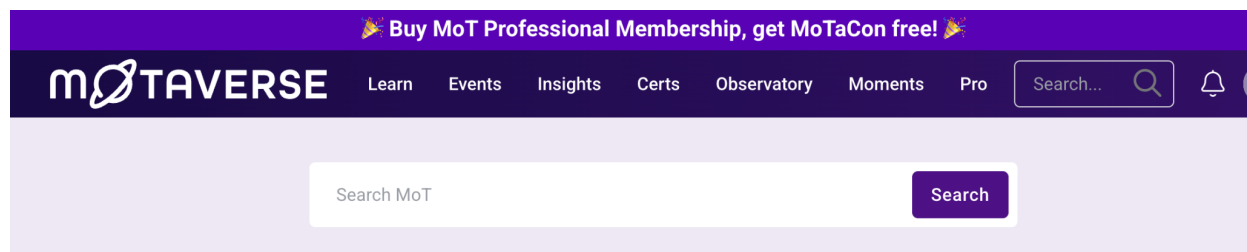

⚠ Selecting an individual interest navigates to a url that appends the term in the url <https://www.ministryoftesting.com/search?q=cypress> yet not results are returned. I see the url is "q=" e.g. <https://www.ministryoftesting.com/search?q=cypress>. Or should it link to other people who have the same interest? I can't remember what we agreed on. I think we settled on it doing a search for that topic as the person who is looking at it is going to be interested in seeing what's available within an interest. This sounds like a good way forward.



💡 How are Interests ordered? Perhaps we should order them in alphabetical order like they are on the existing profile page.

💡 Let's remove "Club Topic" from the list since we're no longer promoting The Club or active on there or even displaying Club Topic cards on the site. It causes confusion if we keep it, as came up in the Ambassador's call.

💡 While "Glossary" is used for the section on the profile page, "Term" is used in the Contributions list. Perhaps it makes sense to rename "Term" to "Glossary Term". Not in the backend, just for display purposes. What do you think?

💡 How about we order the list by highest count descending? Might look nice to have the most "active" items towards the top. Another option is to use a word ladder with the shortest character count first. E.g.

❓ Thinking back to the Activity section. How might we offer a sense of time? I feel like it might be nice to introduce time in this section to help give someone a sense of how long they've been doing things or how recently they've been doing something. Perhaps one of these would help:

- Add the simplest of date stamp so it doesn't clutter each entry e.g. 29/07
- Display the same time indicator from the Activities view e.g. about 12 hours ago, 2 days ago etc
- Under Activity display a start and end month and year e.g. Jan '22 – Jul '26.
- Or maybe on the profile card there's a "Member since MON YY" label

😊 Let's switch to section titles with the new count formatting. Some examples. It looks loads better!
