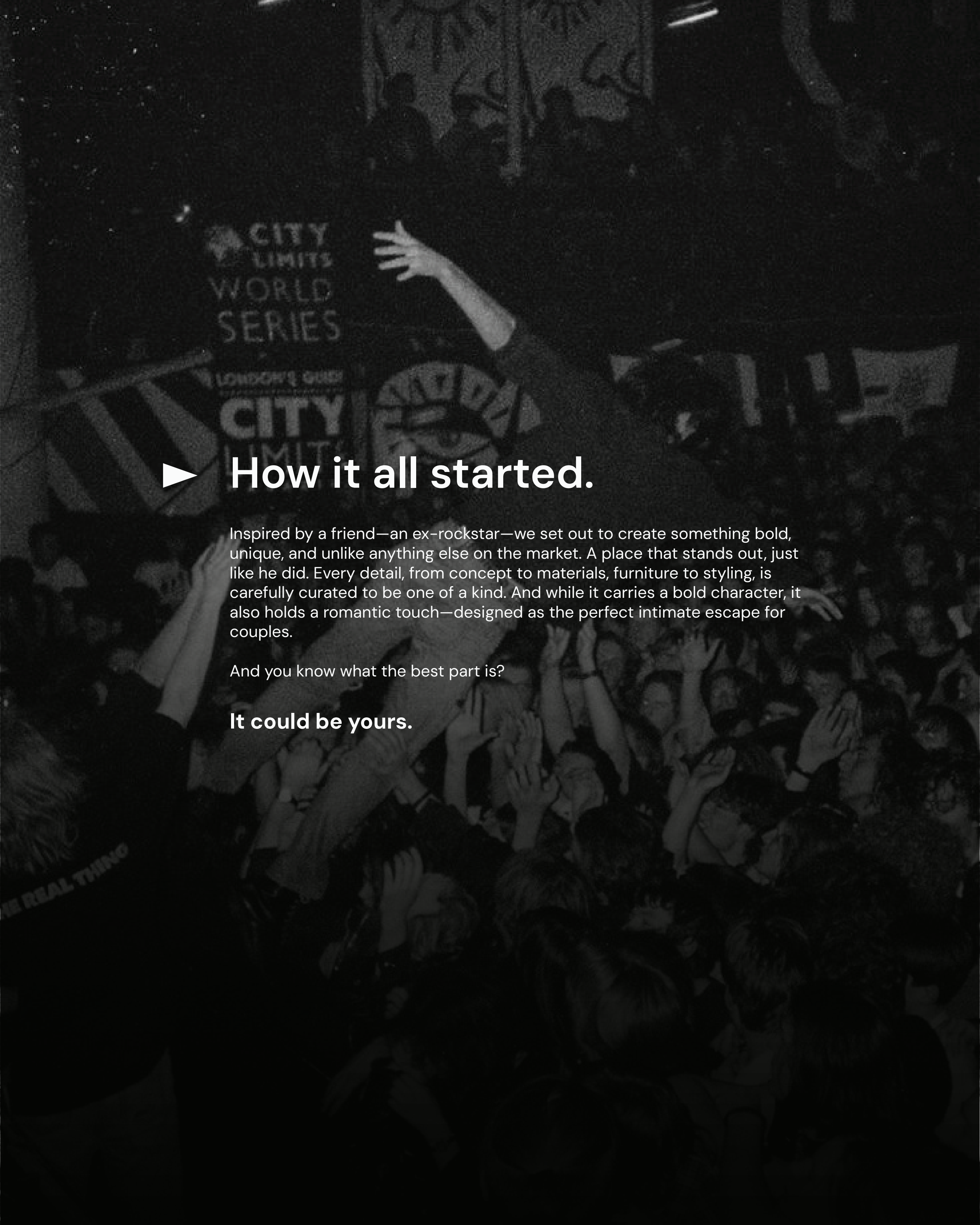

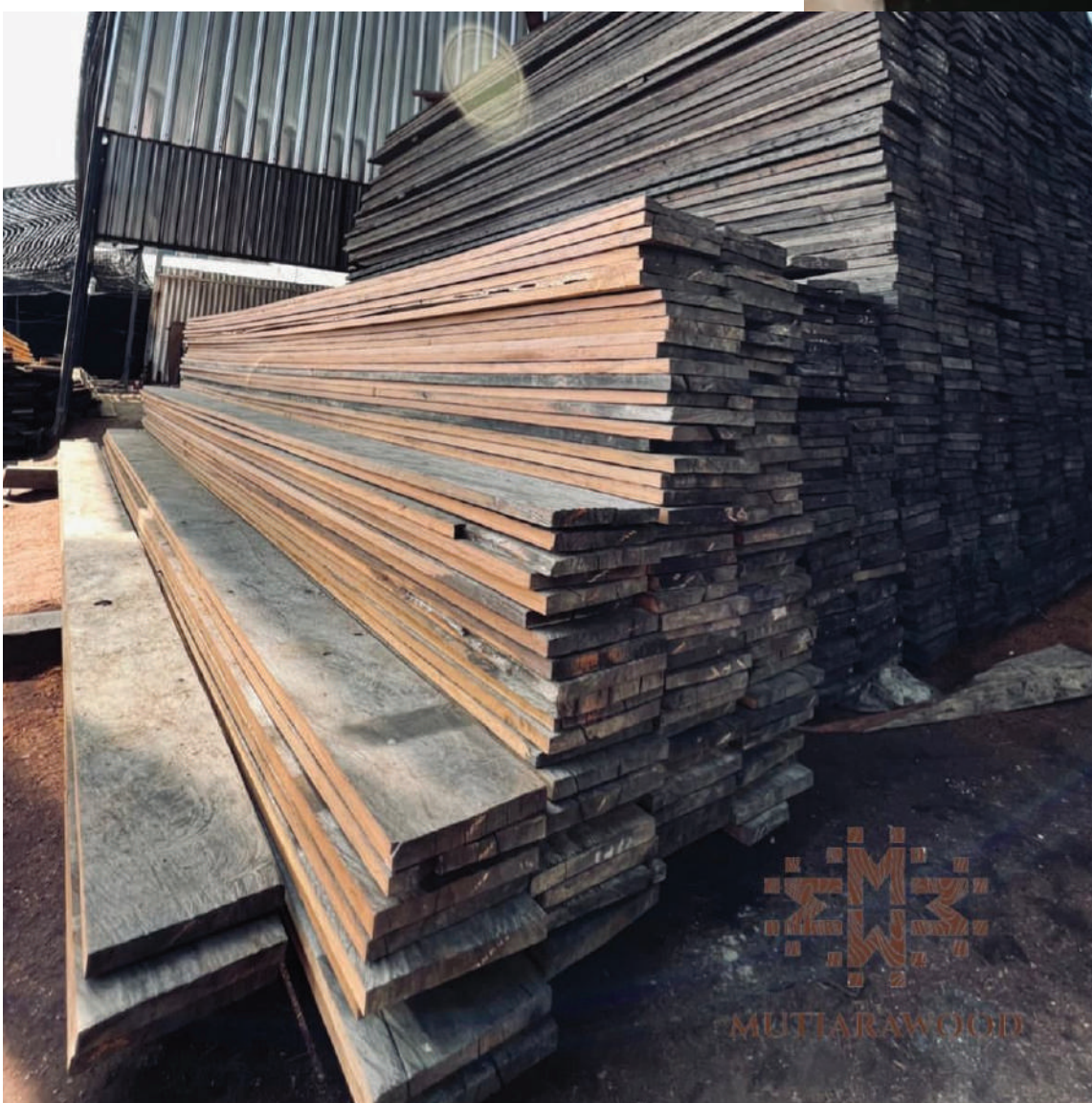
## Terracotta Bricks

Reclaimed ulin wood from @woodguy.-store offers timeless, low-maintenance antique charm.



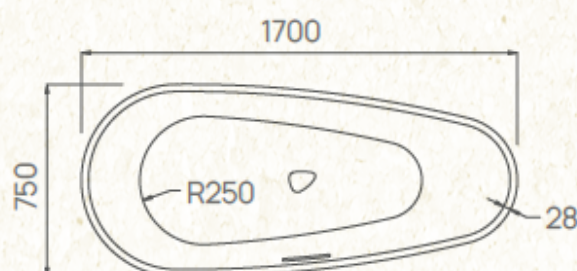
# An Outdoor Bathtub?!

We really mean it when we say we want to “stand out”!

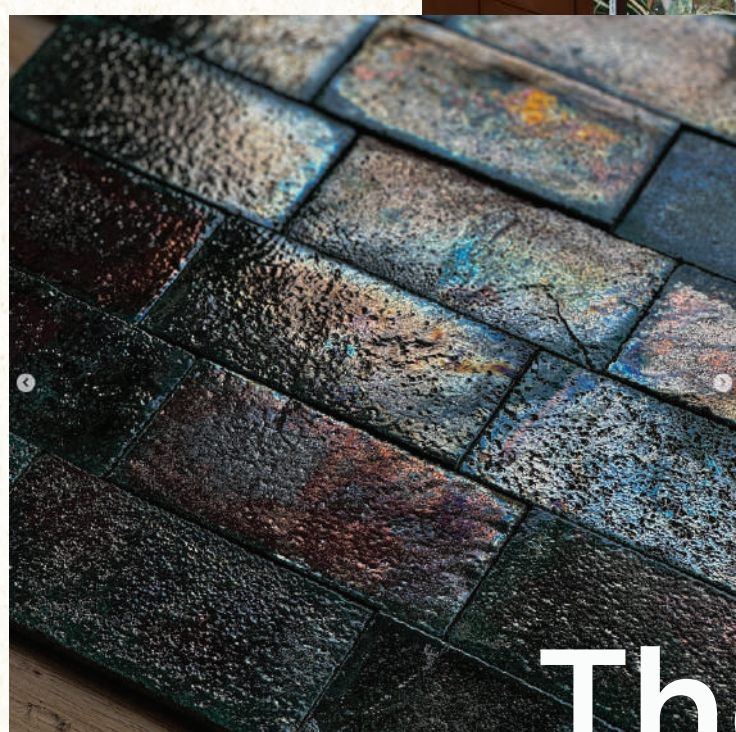
With an iconic freestanding bathtub in the middle of the living area, surrounded by nature, this is more than just a bath—it’s a magical experience.



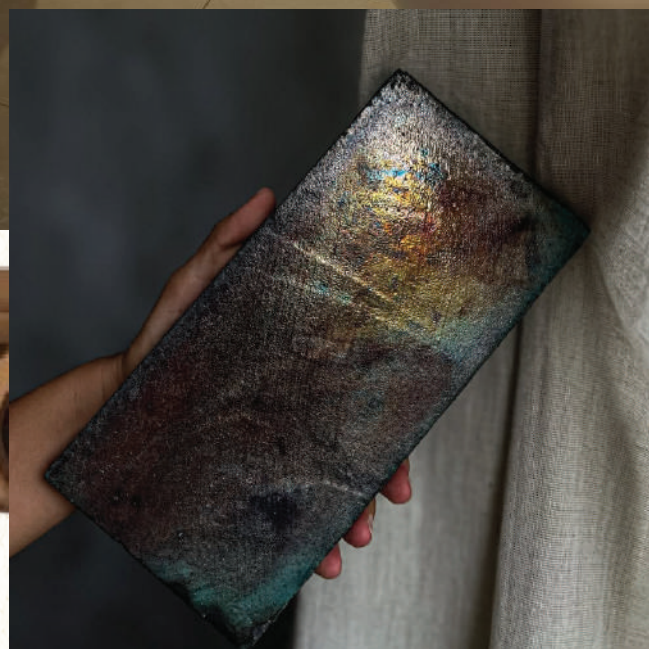

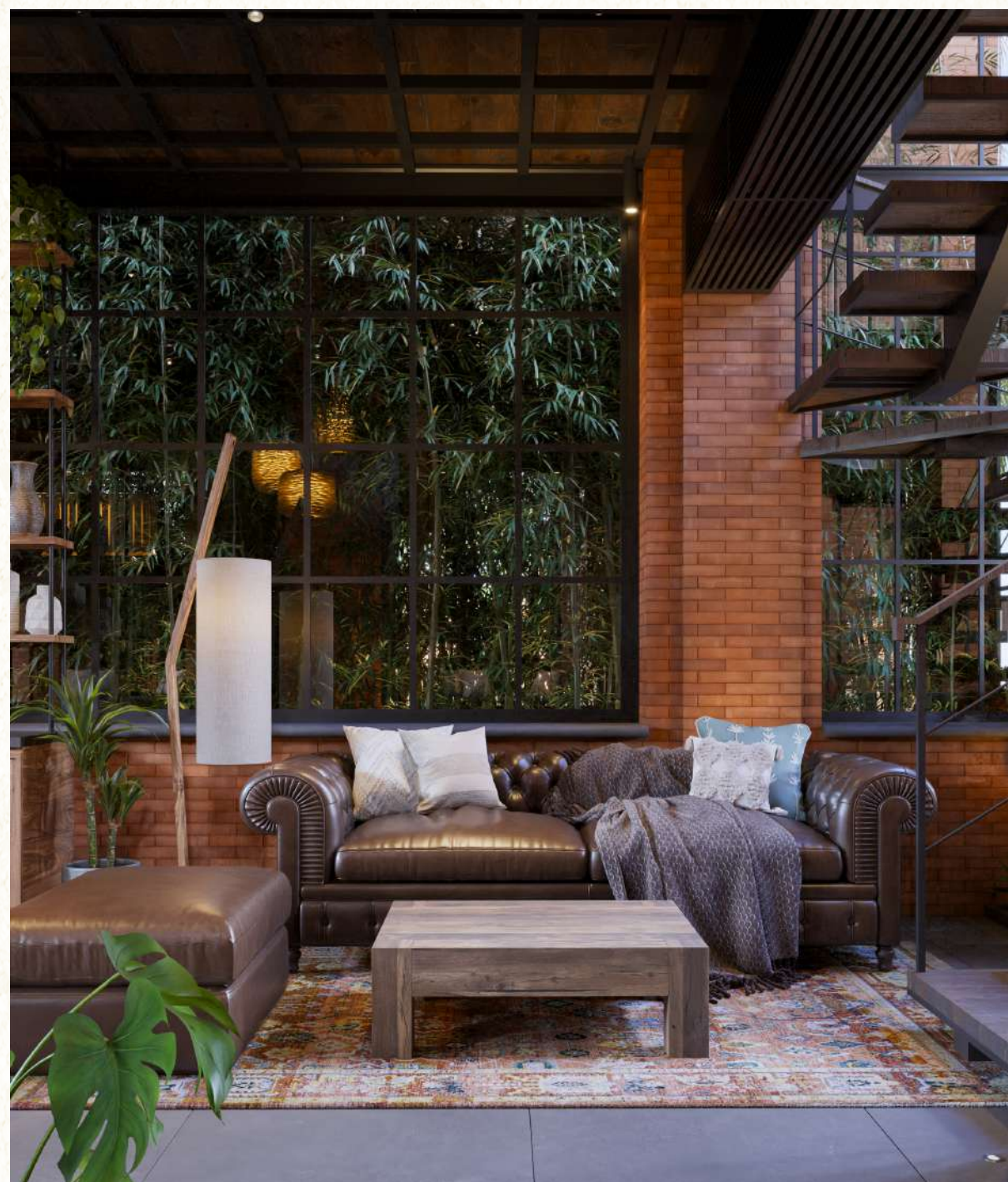
## What room is this, actually?
