

BROADWICKVENUES

Set throughout the cavernous vaults beneath the old Mayfield train station in Manchester, Depot is flexible, multi-use venue that is redefining the city's cultural offering.

Depot is a collaborative project from award-winning developers U+I and Broadwick Venues, the team behind Printworks London and Festival No.6, and is utilising the meanwhile / interim period, before the £1 billion regeneration programme begins.

Mayfield opened in 1910 to alleviate crowding at the adjacent Manchester Piccadilly station. It closed to the public in 1960 and became a service depot for Royal Mail until 1980.

After laying dormant for almost three decades, it hosted a few shows by the Manchester International Festival before Broadwick Venues took up the challenge to transform the disused spaces into a semi-permanent offering, launching with a residency by the renowned Warehouse Project.

Combining arches, vast chamb<mark>ers</mark>, a rooftop platform and sprawling yards, Depot is arguably the most exciting event space in the U.K.



The Yard are capable of hosting between 3,000 - 10,000 guests through to 23:00 (subject to licence).






Concourse opens up on to The Yard, providing a unique inside / out experience, allowing natural light to illuminate the stunning pillared interior.



Depot 2 is an ideal space to host live gigs, brand activations, immersive art or theatre, mid size conferences, exhibitions, film production, photoshoots and much more.


A large open plan area with a series of arches providing opportunities for intimate experiences.

The heart and core of Depot at Mayfield



This stunning location is perfect for film & photography shoots, cinema, brand experiences, F&B, fashion shows, live gigs, DJs, theatre.



Trams


