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## TASTING NOTES:

***Supplied by Ellis of Richmond - contemporary wines, traditional values***

### White Wine

#### Le Pionnier Blanc - Colombard/Ugni Blanc

*A crisp floral white wine from the southwest of France has an aroma of citrus fruits, particularly grapefruit, with hints of ripe pear and tomato leaf. These flavours linger on the palate with hints of exotic fruits, a fresh lime acidity and vivacious finish.*

#### Pinot Grigio - Portenova, Veneto

*This is a typical Pinot Grigio from northeast Italy made by the excellent Fabiano winery on the outskirts of Verona. A brilliant straw yellow colour, elegant perfume of acacia flowers, almonds and dried fruit. A soft, well-balanced palate combines citrus, exotic fruit and fresh apples. Elegant and dry.*

#### Sauvignon Blanc - Astrolabe

*Award winning winemaker, Simon Waghorn, has crafted a fantastic Sauvignon from fruit grown in the Waihopai, Wairau and Brandcott Valleys. Picked in the cool evening to retain acidity and freshness, it is pale straw in colour with green highlights. A fresh aroma of lemon grass and lime peel precedes a panoply of citrus fruit flavours. Refreshing, cool and with a smooth lingering finish.*

#### Chablis - 1er Cru 'Vaucoupin' - Domaine Gautheron

*The excellent Gautheron estate of only 18 hectares in Fleys, to the south east of the region, has been in the Gautheron family for five generations. This traditional style of Chablis is made from old Chardonnay vines grown in the prestige 1er Cru vineyard 'Vaucoupin'. It has fresh, floral aromas of apple blossom combined with a creamy texture and distinct mineral complexity.*

#### Pouilly Fuissé 'Vieilles Vignes' - Domaine Auvigue

*Jean Auvigue is one of the most highly respected specialists of Pouilly in the south of Burgundy. His small domaine produces Pouilly Fuissé of the highest quality with vibrant Chardonnay fruit. It is rich with mineral flavours while a brief maturation in wooden cask adds spice and complexity. This superb crafted white Burgundy was picked by hand from old vines, and is carefully vinified at his cellars in Pouilly. A blend of both stainless steel and oak cask fermentation are used and this helps capture the delicious rich ripe flavours and classic terroir that is unique to these vineyards located below the hill of Solutre.*

### Red Wine

#### Le Pionnier Rouge - Carignan/Grenache

*This soft and fruity Languedoc blend of Grenache and Carignan is generous and supple with an intricate structure. Layers of soft summer fruits and rich berry flavours reflect the warmth of the Mediterranean, with a subtle spicy finish.*

#### Merlot Cabernet - Côtes de Duras Domaine du Grand Mayne

*The red is a classic blend of 70% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Cabernet Franc, vinified to be soft and fruity with gentle tannins. The blend includes a small addition of oak-aged wine to create a softer style to give extra finesse and length.*

#### Bordeaux Supérieur - Château Lescalle

*A superb property located on the edge of the famous Margaux appellation planted with 65% Merlot 15% Cabernet Sauvignon 10% Cabernet Franc and 10% Petit Verdot. Aged in oak and carefully blended, this delicious claret is consistently good, with ripe supple fruit and soft tannins.*

#### Rioja Reserva Azabache - Bodegas Aldeanueva

*This excellent Gran Reserva is selected from the best vineyards from exceptional years. The blend includes 70% Tempranillo, 20% Gamacha and 10% Graciano, which has softened by three years in oak and three more in bottle before release. It shows supple, velvety rich fruit with complex spice and vanilla flavours that linger well into the finish.*

#### Reserve Malbec - Finca Sophenia

*Finca Sophenia is a beautiful estate located in the foothills of the Andes mountains in Tupungato at an altitude of 4,000ft. This allows for a later ripening of the grapes making the tannins smooth and velvety. This Reserve Malbec has an intense deep red colour with violet hues. Complex aromas of plums and ripe cherries and violets. It is enhanced by the presence of dry fruits and mint hints. A wine of great concentration, showing sweet and voluminous tannins and wonderful complexity.*

#### Brouilly 'Vieilles Vignes' - Domaine Dubost

*Brouilly is one of the 10 named 'Cru' villages of Beaujolais, the best vineyards of the region. The Bruyère vineyard is planted on a combination of mineral rich granite and schist soils, which influence the wines overall complexity. It is ripe with red fruits and rounded tannins, and shows exceptional concentration from low yielding 80-year-old Gamay vines. Smooth and refreshing with morello cherry flavours and a light smoky finish.*

#### Pinot Noir - Mt Difficulty 'Roaring Meg'

*This wine exhibits a lovely mix of red and black berry fruits with further complexity gained from oak spice. The wine has a sweet berry entry which displays these same characters in abundance. Tannins rise gracefully out of the mid-palate to finish the wine; these are balanced by the wine's natural acidity and fruit, to produce a long fruit-driven finish.*

## Champagne & Sparkling Wine

### Prosecco - Borgo del Col Alto

*Prosecco is the fashionable dry sparkling wine produced from Prosecco (locally known as Glera) grapes grown in the hills of Treviso, Veneto region. It is a pale and delicate wine with fine mousse and persistent fine bubbles. The clean fruity aromatic bouquet contains hints of flowers, honey and apple leading to a well balanced, light and fresh palate.*

### Champagne - Lanson Black Label NV

*Well known Champagne with the famous Black Label. Universally appreciated this is a classic that embodies the character of a great house. Brilliant golden straw colour with glints of amber. An expressive aroma of springtime scents, and hints of toast and honey precede lively ripe fruit flavours and a vibrant citrus finish on the palate.*

### Champagne - Lanson Rosé Pink Label NV

*Pure colour with pale salmon touches, followed by aromas of roses and red fruit on the nose. Well rounded and fresh on the palate, this wine has harmonious balance and good length on the finish. This is very fine rosé Champagne.*
