The Royal International Convention Centre (Royal ICC) is a state-of-the-art convention centre located just 1.5km from Brisbane's CBD and 15 minutes from Brisbane's Domestic and International Airport, at the historic Brisbane Showgrounds. The Royal ICC offers world-class facilities, onsite accommodation and dining, five star service and menus featuring award-winning produce not offered at any other convention centre. 
Since opening in March 2013, the Royal ICC has hosted high profile local and international guests including Her Royal Highness, Princess Anne, Hollywood superstar Arnold Schwarzenegger, iconic entrepreneur Richard Branson and one of Queensland's top food critics, Des Houghton, who gave rave reviews.

This boutique style convention centre features a unique blend of original hardwood timbers and boasts an industrial heritage façade, with contemporary architectural design providing warmth, character

and charm. Quite simply, the flexibility of the venue lends itself to your imagination.

The 1,500m2 landscaped open Plaza forms the entrance into this multi-level convention centre, which features three flexible exhibition/conference halls, seven meeting rooms, two board rooms and 1,280m2 of foyer space. The Royal ICC is a multipurpose venue capable of holding multiple catered events at any one time.

The world-class Royal ICC is the jewel in the crown when it comes to event spaces at the Brisbane Showgrounds, but there are also a range of outdoor facilities on offer. These include the iconic Main Arena with grandstands capable of accommodating around 20,000 people plus other unique facilities including Marquee 1 (5,535m2) and Marquee 2 (2,250m2) – permanent, all weather structures suitable for parking, music festivals and exhibitions.



Award-winning food & beverage

The Royal International Convention Centre menu showcases its unique connection to Australian farmers.

For 145 years, the RNA has celebrated and championed agriculture through its Royal Queensland Show (Ekka) and food and beverage competitions. In fact, the Royal ICC is the only convention centre in Australia where guests can enjoy produce awarded medals in these competitions.

Through this connection, the world-class chefs have formed close relationships with the competition entrants - Australia's finest farmers and producers - learning the story behind each high-quality ingredient used.

With so much award-winning produce grown right here in southeast Queensland, the menu has a strong local focus. The chefs know every event is unique, so they can also tailor menus to suit any event need or dietary requirement.

The menu also features a chef's signature series, with the chefs giving recommendations across a range of sections from plated menus to working buffets.

One of the recommendations is the Charred Carvery live station, serving Royal Queensland Food and Wine Show (RQFWS) gold medal-winning 400 day grain fed Tajima wagyu and artisan bread rolls.

The station was introduced to the Royal ICC's menu following its overwhelming popularity at Queensland's largest event the Royal Queensland Show (Ekka) in August 2019, where more than 8,700 rolls were served.

The talented chefs have also re-imagined the way they prepare and deliver plant-based foods, with the dishes including a spiced cauliflower main and coconut yoghurt dessert.

Rydges Hotel

The four and a half star Rydges Hotel is conveniently located directly across the road from the Royal ICC, giving guests the option of onsite accommodation.

The contemporary 208 room hotel features a bar, restaurant, 24 hour gym and heated outdoor swimming pool.

There are also a variety of 3-5 star alternative accommodation options located within close proximity to the Royal ICC.

King Street


King Street is one of Brisbane's most popular dining and retail precincts.





Operable Ceiling Grid System

A structural feature within the Royal ICC, the operable ceiling grid system offers some key features which benefit our clients and their events:

- 36 operable grids each featuring 3 phase and 15 amp power and capable of carrying 2.4 tonne evenly distributed
- Grids are lowered by remote control, enabling timely installation of technical equipment from a safe floor level work height
- Faster and easier hanging of banners and key event signage minimising labour and plant hire




