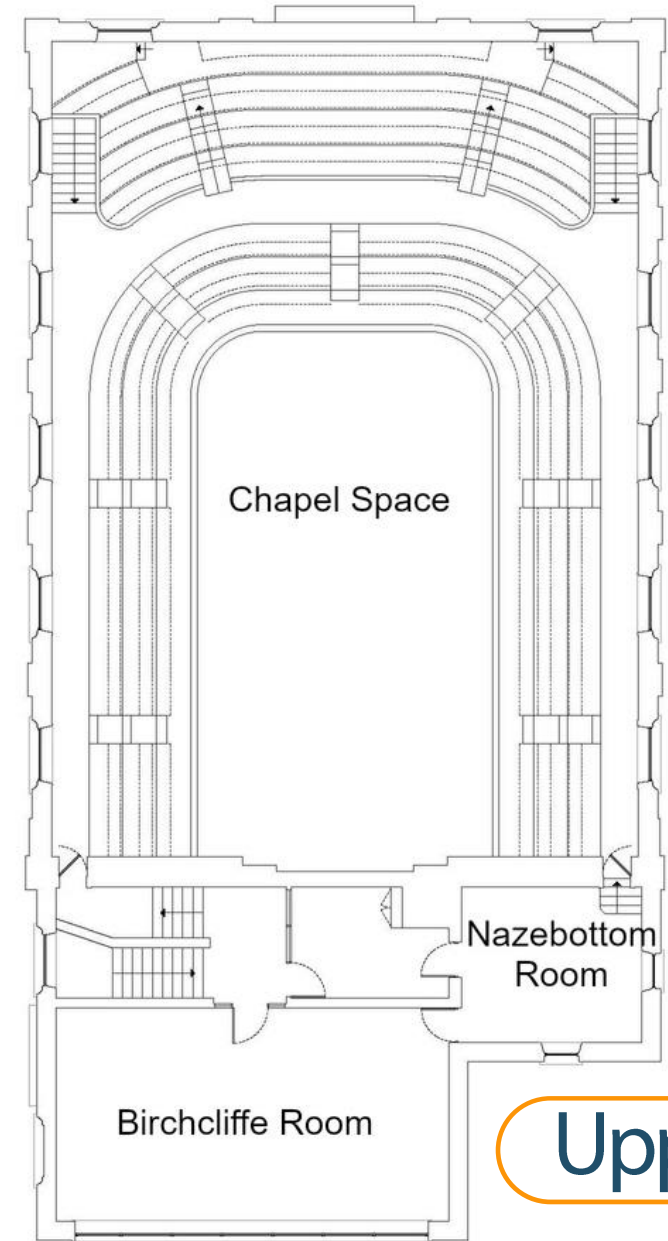
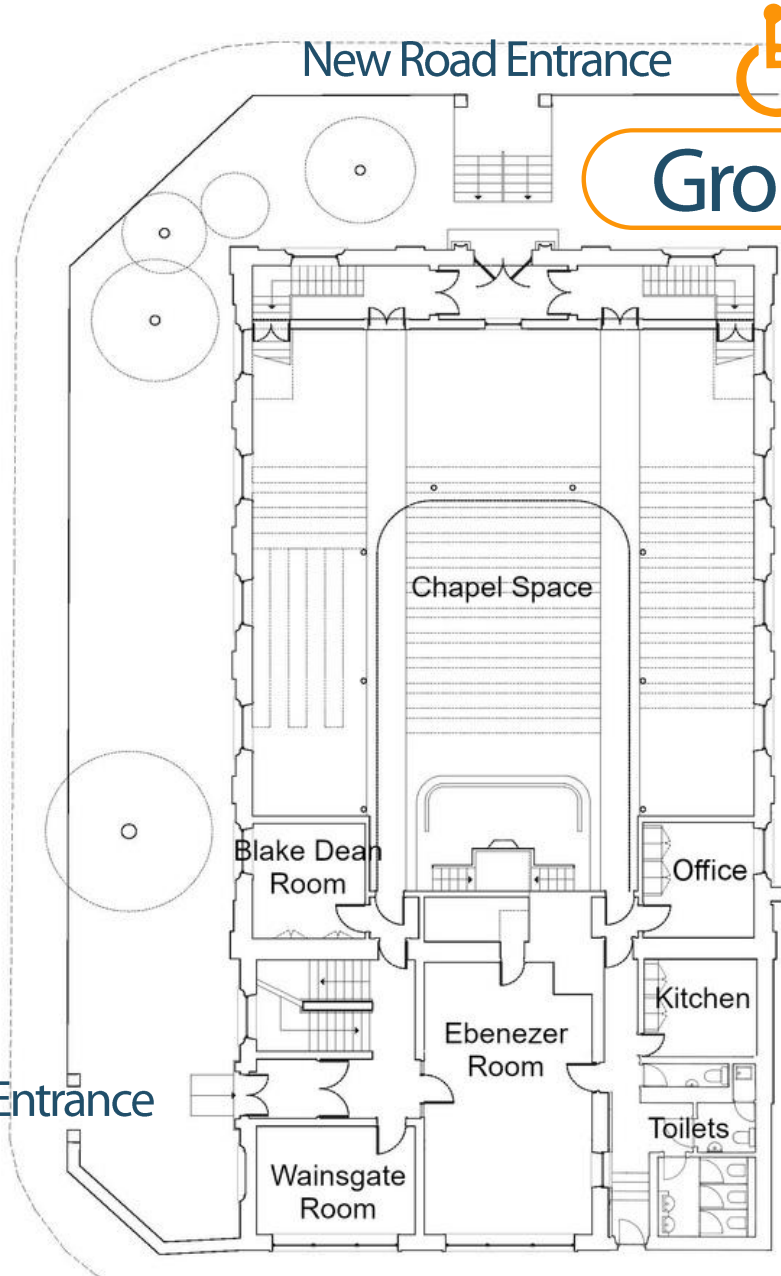


New Road Entrance

The Chapel space offers an ambience and acoustic quality unlike any other venue in the valley. We have experience in hosting live events, from blues and choral music, to spoken word and wellbeing activities. We are open to creative ideas, such as community gatherings or album launches, with the option of online and in-person events.

Original listed features, including lovingly restored pews and plasterwork, exist alongside high-fidelity sound equipment and a sophisticated heat recovery and ventilation system. The venue has fixed wooden pews, with cushioned seating on the ground floor. These are gently raked front to back, giving good views of the raised stage positioned between the beautiful pulpit and rostrum rail.

- Heritage board table with inlaid leather
- Standard chairs
- Easy access to kitchen and bathrooms
- Access to the Chapel to pause and reflect
- Accessible room for wheelchair users.

Can be combined with the Ebenezer Room (via a folding partition) to create space to seat up to 50.

Wainsgate Room

Ground Floor

Capacity: 8-10

5m x 3.5m

Ebenezer +Wainsgate: 50



Our largest ground floor room, ideally suited to meetings, workshops or community discussions where a flexible layout is important.

Features:

- Picture windows for natural light
- Vertical blinds allowing room blackout
- Pull-down projector screen
- Easy access to collapsible tables and chairs
- Easy access to kitchen and bathrooms
- Most accessible room for wheelchair users.

Can be combined with the Wainsgate Room (via a folding partition) to create space to seat up to 50.

Ebenezer Room

Ground Floor

Capacity: 40

8.8m x 5.3m

Ebenezer+Wainsgate: 50



A cosy and private room with armchairs, ideally suited to informal meetings or one-to-one work.

Features:

- Tall arched windows for natural light
- Quiet location in the building
- Easy access to kitchen and bathrooms
- Heritage furniture and artwork
- Access to the Chapel to pause and reflect
- Accessible room for wheelchair users

The Blake Dean room can be included when you hire the Chapel space, being ideally located as a secure Green Room for performers.

Blake Dean Room

Ground Floor

Capacity: 4-6

3.75m x 3.5m



Nazebottom might be our smallest room, but it's full of potential. It is secluded and restful, perfect for a few hours of undisturbed work or a small but focused meeting.

Features:

- Arched windows for natural light
- Heritage table
- Heritage chairs or standard chairs, if you prefer
- Quiet, peaceful location
- Access to kitchen and bathrooms is via stairs
- Access to the Chapel to pause and reflect
- Regrettably, not wheelchair accessible

Nazebottom Room

First Floor

Capacity: 4-5

5m x 4m



Best suited for rehearsals, workshops & creative activities, owing to the outstanding natural light, expansive space and flexible furniture options.

Features:

- Picture windows
- Vertical blinds allowing room blackout
- Heritage benches
- Enough space for rehearsal piano + movement
- Easy access to collapsible tables and chairs
- Access to our library of curiosities
- Access to kitchen and bathrooms via stairs
- Access to the Chapel to pause and reflect
- Regrettably, not wheelchair accessible

Birchcliffe Room

First Floor

Capacity: 60-70

10.5m x 5.8m



We have beautifully refurbished kitchen facilities, ideal for creating light refreshments and drinks for small parties.

Features:

- Domestic kettle/11.5L hot water boiler and urns
- Domestic oven and electric hob
- Domestic microwave
- Large domestic fridge and freezer spaces
- Separate handwashing and dishwashing sinks
- Heritage & modern crockery
- Expansive array of serveware
- Wheeled serving trolley
- Recycling facilities

Our bathroom facilities have also been beautifully refurbished, and equipped with a wheelchair accessible toilet and baby change space.

Accessibility

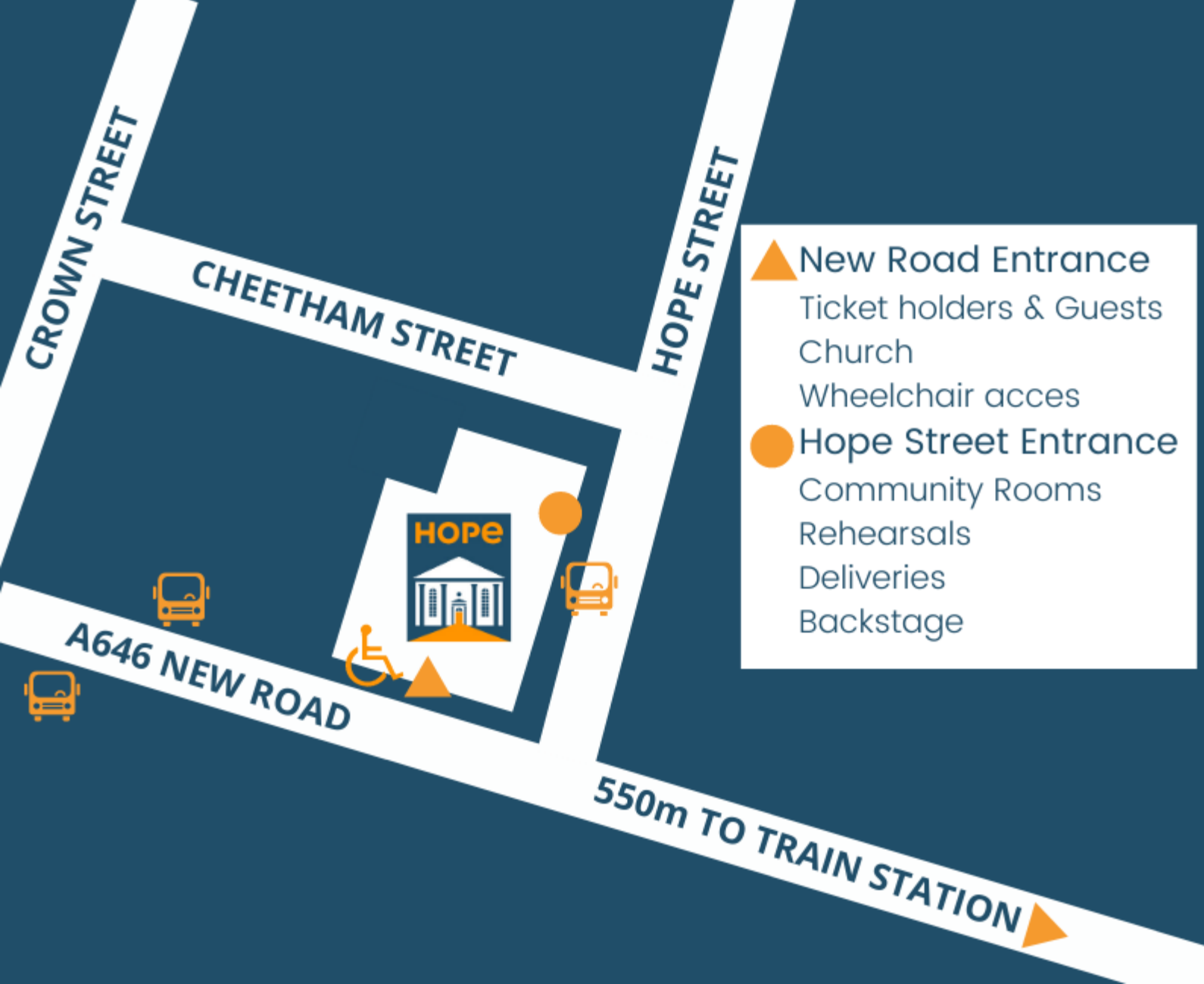
A DDA-compliant ramp allows stepless access to the main chapel entrance on New Road, from where there is level access throughout the ground floor. All ground floor rooms are wheelchair accessible including one modified toilet space. A steeper ramp has been installed on the side entrance on Hope Street.

Our demountable stage is reached via steps. The area in front of the stage is wheelchair friendly and it is perfectly possible for artists who use wheelchairs to use this space as their stage. An area has been set aside at the front of the Chapel, under the gallery, for audience members who use wheelchairs.

Currently there is no lift to provide wheelchair access to our first floor rooms.

A T-loop hearing system is permanently installed in the Chapel and a portable T-loop device is available for use in the community rooms.

Parking and Location

Hope Chapel is conveniently located on the main road through Hebden Bridge. We are moments away from bus and rail links and close to on-street meter parking on Cheetham street, or pay-and-display car parks. There is no parking on Hope Street or New Road.
