

ORMOND HALL, EASTERN BAR & EASTERN BAR COURTYARD

Built in 1891, Ormond Hall is a heritage listed dance hall and theatre with a warm and inviting aesthetic. Originally refurbished in the 1920s, the Art Deco period finishes from this era have been retained, creating a neutral yet nostalgic space with polished timber floors, lead glass windows, ornate iron balustrades, faceted milk glass pendants and richochre stage curtains.

Ormond Hall is centrally located on St Kilda Road, within walking distance to several trams to and from the CBD. This premium and charming environment provides the perfect backdrop for a myriad of events from weddings to special birthday celebrations and corporate entertaining.

BAR MOUBRAY

Dark, sultry and oh-so-sexy, Bar Moubray is a bit of a smooth talker - it will have your full attention from the moment you arrive. Liquor License Guidelines



COVID Safe Practices




Parking
