Sparkling

3B Filipa Pato Brut Rosé, Bairrada, Portugal, NV £42

Lovely aromatics and refreshing acidity, this is that perfect aperitif. Made by the traditional method, blend of indigenous Baga and Bical varieties.

The Grand Duchess, Hattingley Valley, Hampshire, UK, 2019 £48

Our own label English sparkling, made exclusively for us. An aromatic blend of Bacchus & Pinot Gris. Refreshing green fruit, tart, and stylistically a wine of England.

X Bulles, Mousseux Brut, Vincent Caille, Loire, France, NV £54

Method Ancestral fizz, blend of Melon de Bourgogne and Côt (Malbec). Dry and rich with fragrant raspberry fruit on the palate. Uplifting and fun, very smashable at 11.5% abv.

Langham Estate, Culver, Classic Cuvee, Dorset, UK, NV £75

We think this is one of the best English sparkling wine on the market. Red apple, citrus and a dry developed complex & nutty finish.

Lancelot Pienne, Accord Majeur, Champagne, France, NV £87

Our house champagne, blend of 70% Meunier, 15% Chardonnay, 15% Pinot Noir, predominantly from Grand Cru vineyards and aged in the solera system. As a result of 4 years of ageing on lees, this is an exquisite and rich style of champagne that you must try at least once.

Pol Roger, Brut Reserve, Champagne, France, NV £90

Best known as Winston Churchill's favourite champagne. This house's signature cuvée offers an exquisite balance between elegance and richness.

Benoit Lahaye, Grand Cru Brut Nature, Champagne, France, NV £120

A rich and oxidative style of wine. It's going to catch the real gourmands by surprise. It's long, evolved and really very special.

Sparkling Magnums

Classic Reserve, Hattingley Valley, Lower Wield, Hampshire UK, NV £155 magnum

We've been working with Hattingley since the day we opened. The magnums have longer lees ageing and more time on cork. They're singing at the moment.

Classic Rosé, Hattingley Valley, Lower Wield, Hampshire UK, 2014 £190 magnum

Drinking really well now, blend of Pinot Noir, Meunier & Pinot Précoce. This is sophisticated and rich sparkling rosé, aged 18 months on its lees. It shows delicate red fruit and fine toasty character. Last magnum left in our cellar!

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White

Catarratto, Cantine Amato, Messina, Sicily, Italy, 2021 £34

Catarratto is an indigenous grape variety of Sicily. This is a real crowd pleaser and perfect for the winter months. Soft, savoury, rich notes of apple, peach and spice.

Vinho Verde Loureiro, Muros Antigos, Anselmo, Portugal, 2021 £38

Anselmo Mendes has a fantastic reputation for producing some of the best wines in Portugal. This is 100% Loureiro with all the freshness from the Atlantic Ocean, crisp acidity and underlying salinity.

Sauvignon Blanc, Illmitzer, Helmut Lang, Burgenland, Austria, 2021 £42

Made by Helmut Jr who is bringing a new generational input in the long-standing reputation that his father has built up. Fresh and fragrant Sauvignon with distinctive green apple and passion fruit. Extremely easy-drinking.

Chenin Blanc, Manoir de la Tête d'Ange, Saumur Blanc, Loire, France, 2020 £54

Pleasant acidity, touch of honeysuckle, jasmine and treacle. It's refreshing, great lunchtime drinking and perfect for dishes with rich sauces.

Txakolina, Txakoli, Basque, Spain, 2021 £55

This is a famous Basque country wine, usually a spritzy thirst quencher, but this is more on the serious side. Stunning and fine Txakolina, juicy and mineral with a salty edge. Perfect with our seafood.

Albariño, Komokabras, Adegas Entre os Rios, Galicia, Spain, 2021 £58

Granite soils, a sea salt breeze blowing from the Atlantic, touch of skin contact, barrel and lees ageing, this Albariño is exceptional. Racy and mineral.

Chardonnay, Land of Saints, Santa Barbara County, California, 2021 £65

Wonderfully rich and mineral Chardonnay, reminiscent of a Meursault. Juicy lemon zest with saline and pie crust flavours. Give me more!

Sancerre, Francois Crochet, Loire Valley, France, 2021 £76

A delicious and generous Sancerre, showing more weight and texture together with the classic crisp and mineral expression.

Chablis 1er Cru, Montmains, Domaine Garnier, Burgundy, France, 2018 £86

A rich yet elegant expression of Chablis. Picture yourself out on the water, oyster in hand. You wouldn't want to be without a bottle of this.

Assyrtiko 34, Artemis Karamolegos, Santorini, Greece, 2020 £88

Outstanding Assyrtiko, rich and complex with an excellent salty mineral edge. Artemis being one of the most dynamic wineries on this unique island.

White Magnums

Muscadet Sèvre & Maine sur Lie, Pierre-Marie & Marie Luneau, Loire, France, 2020 £80

This delicious, crowd-pleaser of a wine hails from Muscadet at the start of the Loire Valley. It's fun, succulent and dry.

Folio, Collioure Blanc, Coume del Mas, Roussillon, France, 2020 £120

A rich and weighty Grenache Blanc with a mineral edge. Grown on the schist soils of the South of France this wine is decadent and exciting.

Riesling Tradition, Schloss Gobelsburg, Burgenland, Austria, 2013 £165

Aged Riesling is both refreshing and beguiling. Tart lime notes with whispers of tropical fruit. A real showstopper and the centrepiece libation of your event.

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Rosé

MiP Rosé, Made in Provence, Domaine Des Diabes, France, 2021 £39

One of our biggest sellers. One whiff will take you straight to the hillsides of Provence. Delicate, dry, medium-bodied rosé, superb with our seafood, joyful, textbook stuff.

Tête de la Rouge, Les Fontenelles Rosé, Saumur, Loire, France, 2020 £48

Sancerre Rosé like in style but made from Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon. Perfectly delicious and mineral with plenty of fruit flavours on the palate. Made by minimal intervention, just good honest wine.

Orange

Blonde by Nature, Pittnauer, Burgenland, Austria, 2021 £54

Aromatic and juicy orange wine that will make you happy. Enticing tropical fruit and orange blossom with smoky minerality. Made from Grüner Veltliner, Pinot Blanc and Chardonnay. Bottled unfiltered to preserve the flavour so expect slight haziness.

Red

Zweigelt, Zantho, Burgenland, Austria, 2021 £32

A fabulously rich and juicy Zweigelt, fruity in style with fine acidity and sweet spice.

Grenache, Bosman Family Vineyards, Wellington, South Africa, 2021 £34

A softer and more delicate expression of Grenache, deliciously easy drinking and unpretentious wine.

Gamay, Domaine De La Grosse Pierre, Beaujolais, France, 2021 £38

An incredibly juicy and expressive Beaujolais, showing great balance and high quality for such young Gamay. Made by talented Pauline Passot who discovered wine in a bar in Ireland, and now creating serious terroir-driven and exciting wines.

Artuke, Bodegas Artuke, Rioja, Spain, 2020 £42

A deliciously fresh blend of Tempranillo & Viura that goes through semi carbonic maceration. Very low tannins and punnets of strawberries.

Sangiovese, Il Ghizzano, Tenuta Di Ghizzano, Tuscany, Italy, 2019 £58

Lovely lightly chilled, plenty of welcoming sweet cherry fruit. Blended with 5% of Merlot gives it a touch of refinement and crunchy texture.

Cabernet Franc, Antoine Sanzay, La Paterne, Saumur Champigny, Loire, France, 2020 £66

Smooth and lush Cabernet Franc with its typical herbaceous streak. Grown on the sandy soft soil famous in the region known as tuffeau, making the wine from this area lighter and more refreshing.

St. Joseph, Chateau Morel, Jean-Baptiste Souillard, Rhone, France, 2019 £90

Syrah. Floral notes of bergamot with ripe dark fruit. This is serious stuff for nig red wine drinkers.

Pommard, En Brescul, Violot-Guillemard, Burgundy, France, 2017 £135

Charming, lifted and powerful Pommard. Pinot Noir's attractive red fruit perfume is matched perfectly with savoury, mineral core. This 2017 is drinking beautifully.

Red Magnums

Lirac, Romain Le Bars, Rhône, France, 2019 £155

Classic Southern Rhône blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre and Carignan, but using little to no sulphur, this wine is about drinkability. It goes down by itself!

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Sweet

Beerenauslese, Scheurebe, Umathum, Burgenland, Austria, 2019 £48 half bottle
Lush golden colour with a sensational balance between sweet honey and citrusy freshness. Too morish to share!

Banyuls Rimage, Galateo, Coume del Mas, Roussillon, France, 2018 £53 half bottle
Gnarly old vine Grenache on steep slopes a stone's throw away from the sea. Deep in colour with wild strawberry notes. Great for chocolate pud.

Boal Madeira 10yr, Medium Sweet,, H.M. Borges, Funchal, Madeira £50 bottle
An unbelievable wine that can be drunk with dessert, by itself or with main dishes. Orange peel, toasted almonds, black tea and mouth watering acidity.
