OVERVIEW

In the heart of Covent Garden piazza, and set in London's original flower market, London Transport Museum provides two unique spaces for all event types.

The Museum Galleries provide an interactive and immersive experience where guests can exclusively explore London's transport history across two floors of exhibitions including iconic red buses, trams and early Tube carriages. The Museum Galleries provides a memorable backdrop for dinners, award ceremonies, product launches and private

celebrations. Working with some of London's finest caterers we can accommodate up to 230 guests for a seated dinner and 600 guests standing.

The Cubic Theatre is a purpose-built auditorium featuring distinctive moquette seats, perfect for conferences, training sessions and high-quality film screenings. A high-spec short throw projector ensures slick presentations. The adjoining Foyer can be used for registration, catering and breakouts with great branding opportunities.

MUSEUM GALLERIES

London Transport Museum occupies the original Victorian flower market, and the Museum Galleries span two floors.

The versatile space transports guests through the ages and offers the opportunity to explore the world recognisable red Routemaster, early tube carriages and original Metropolitan trains.

Much of the collection housed at London Transport Museum is interactive, including our Future Engineers gallery, where budding tube drivers of tomorrow can jump on a driving simulator.

Beneath a stunning glass ceiling, the Galleries can be transformed for a host of events including private dining, cocktail receptions and product launches. Working with a select list of preferred suppliers, the Museum delivers polished events in a central location.



CUBIC THEATRE

The Cubic Theatre is perfect for seminars, conferences and film screenings.

It features specially-designed moquette seats which are conveniently tiered. Our built in flexible 'plug and play' system allows easy use and control over content, lighting and sound.

The adjoining foyer provides a breakout space suitable for registration, lunch or networking drinks for events with up to **80 guests**.

With complimentary Museum access for all guests, break times at London Transport Museum are inspiring and interactive.



CUBIC FOYER

Hidden below the famous cobbles of Covent Garden piazza sits the Cubic Foyer.

This recently renovated space offers a sound proofed private meeting setting with distinctive moquette seats for up to 40 in cabaret style layout or 23 in boardroom style layout.

Large display screens can be used to showcase company logos and play presentations or videos, available with our 'plug and play' flexible set up.

The versatile space allows delegates to use the Foyer for workshop activity and a purpose-built magnetic wall can be used for displaying group work, brainstorming or paper-based presentations.

LTM works with Benugo to offer a wide range of fresh and seasonal menus throughout your day.

All guests benefit from complimentary access to the Museum galleries, ensuring inspiring and interactive meetings to remember.



FILMING AT ACTON DEPOT

The Museum Depot in Acton holds the vast majority of the Museum's collections which are not on display in the main Museum in Covent Garden.

More than 370,000 items including original works of art, vehicles, signs, models, photographs, engineering drawings and uniforms, form one of the most comprehensive records of urban transport anywhere in the world.

Crews have access to green room facilities, as well as free onsite parking and a dedicated onsite supervisor. Onsite power is available where possible.

For filming and photography, we have a number of underground carriages available that include the Victoria Line (1967-2011) tube carriage with driver's cabin access, a 1950s-present day Metropolitan line train and a refurbished Met 353 first class carriage from the early 1900s.

The carriages are excellent for internal and external filming along with a number of buses that include original posters and advertisements.

Feeling adventurous?

Venture out into the network on our award-winning Hidden London guided tours. Explore disused Tube stations, forgotten platforms and secret spaces, all hidden behind the closed doors of the Underground. We have 10 sites on offer including the disused Jubilee line platforms of Charing Cross, former station Aldwych, and a wartime deep-level shelter underneath Clapham South station.

Tours last between 70 and 90 minutes and can accommodate between 12 to 25 guests. Private tours are also available, starting from £1,300 + VAT. Please enquire for more details.

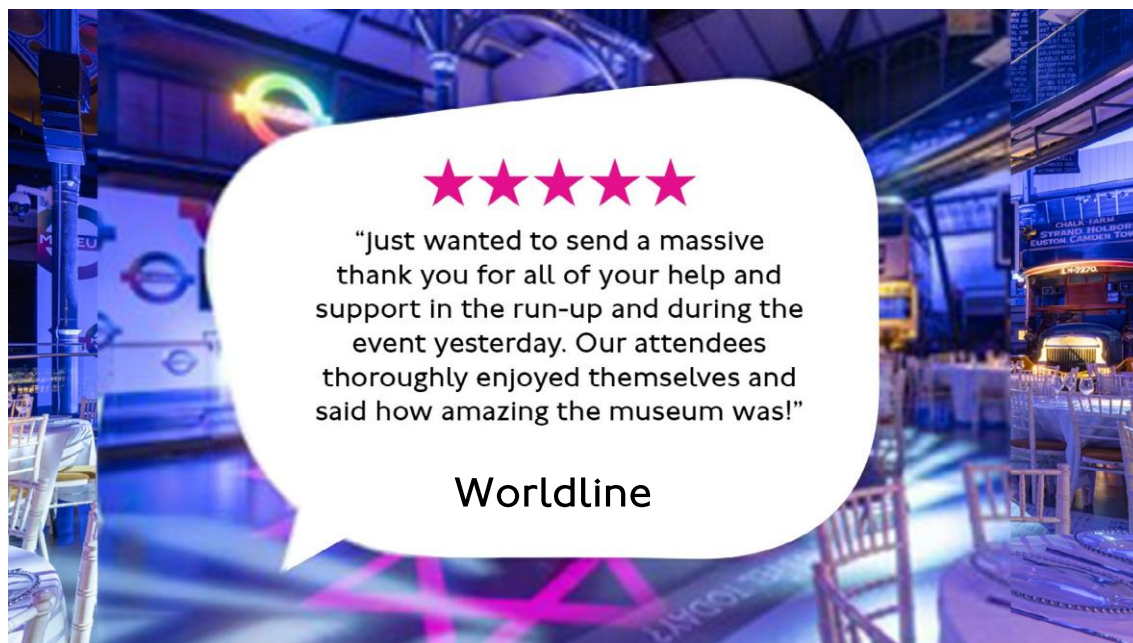
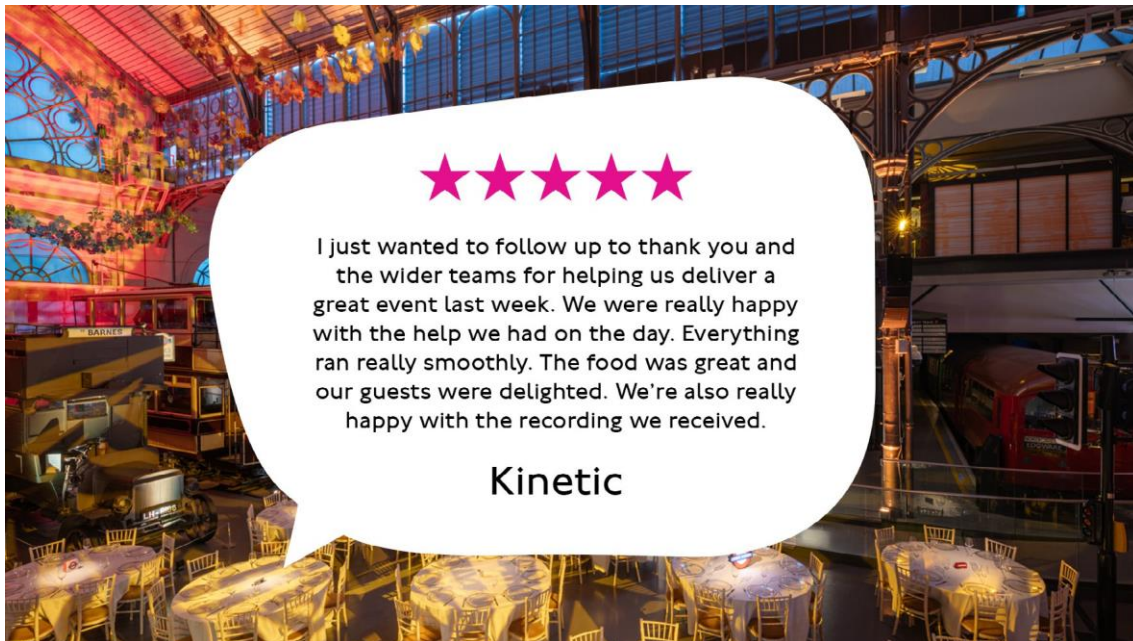
LTM Shop:

FAQS

What time can I access the venue?

- Clients can access the space 30 minutes before the contracted event start time. This will be 6pm at the earliest for museum events whilst we remain open to the public.
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Are your spaces accessible?

- The museum is accessible for wheelchair users with level access at the Ticket Desk, and lifts to all floors. There are ramps in some areas. Due to the historic nature of our collection, not all the vehicles are accessible. The area outside the Museum is cobbled, with a level path part of the way round.
