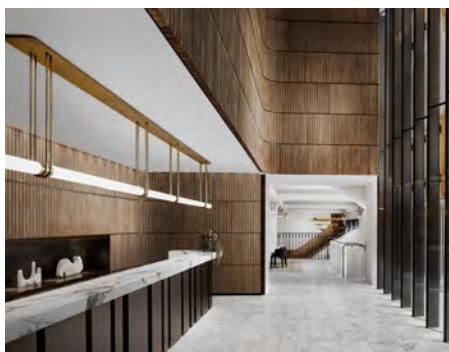
FACILITIES AND SERVICES

FITNESS CENTER

Hilton Melbourne Little Queen Street invites guests to the exclusive use of a range of health and fitness amenities on their stay. HOTEL HISTORY TOUR

Hilton Melbourne Little Queen Street's self-guided hotel history tour is open to all guests and reveals the colourful past and significance of the site over the course of a short walk around the public spaces in the hotel via digital QR codes. There are eight QR codes on the tour, which when scanned using a mobile device reveal the building's secrets.



MEETINGS AND EVENTS

Hilton Melbourne Little Queen Street is an ideal spot to hold unforgettable private events. The 5 event rooms are imbued with Art Deco aesthetics, natural light and lots of character.

- Gorman Room & Chambers Room can accommodate up to 49-55 guests each, or 104 guests when combined (covering 143 m² of floor space).
- Trustees Room covers 40 m² and accommodating up to 55 guests.
- Oakley & Parkes Boardroom is a boardroom for up to 10 guests, covering 24 m² of floor space and featuring a large table and comfortable seating.
- Equity Room is an attractive 25 m² room accommodating between 10 and 40 guests in various seating styles.
- The generous sized pre-functions area can be used for either Trade / Exhibition Space or Catering.



DINING

Gastronomy is a primary focus of Hilton Melbourne Little Queen Street, offering the perfect venue for a sophisticated dining experience for both epicurean travellers and local Melburnians.

LUCI

Luci pays tribute to the city's vibrant culinary culture, to which the Italian immigrants arriving in the 1950s served as the backbone. Its menu curated by Executive Chef Sam Moore features modern Australian cooking accentuated with hints of Italian and European culinary traditions.
