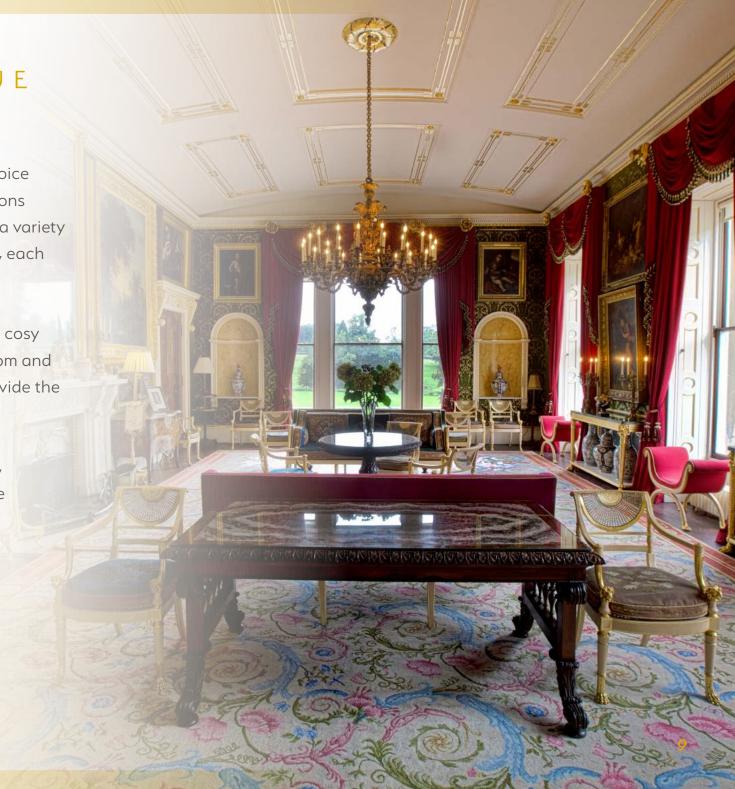

For those seeking an outdoor experience, our Yurt and Fire Temple offer picturesque spaces amidst nature, ideal for hosting memorable events.

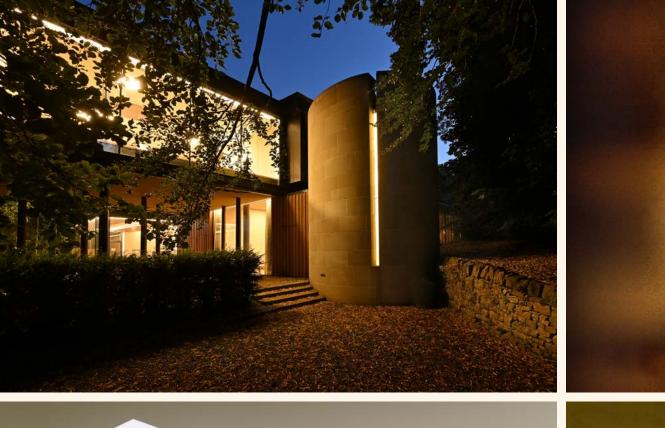

HOW TO GET HERE

The Yorkshire Dales is a beautiful area in the centre of the UK. We are easy to get to, either by train, car or plane. The closest train station is Skipton (5 minutes) or Leeds (40 minutes) and we are easily accessible from Manchester, Liverpool or London by car or train.

By Road 4-5 hours from London (traffic dependent). From M1, leave at Junction 42 onto M62. Join M606 and follow signs for Skipton.

By Rail The nearest train station is Skipton, Broughton Road, Skipton BD23 1RT (10 minute drive from Broughton Hall Estate). Trains from London Kings Cross are only three hours (single change at Leeds).
