

## The Lord Byron Room

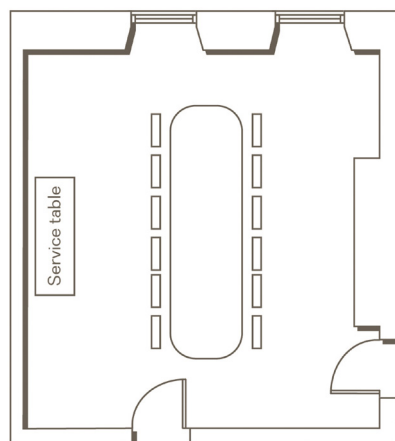


Named after Lord Byron, the Romantic poet and politician. Byron's fortune, entrusted to his butler James Brown, led to the birth of Brown's Hotel.
