With versatile seating a central bar and a terrace with parasols and heaters, The Grand Saloon is perfect for larger gatherings and celebrations.





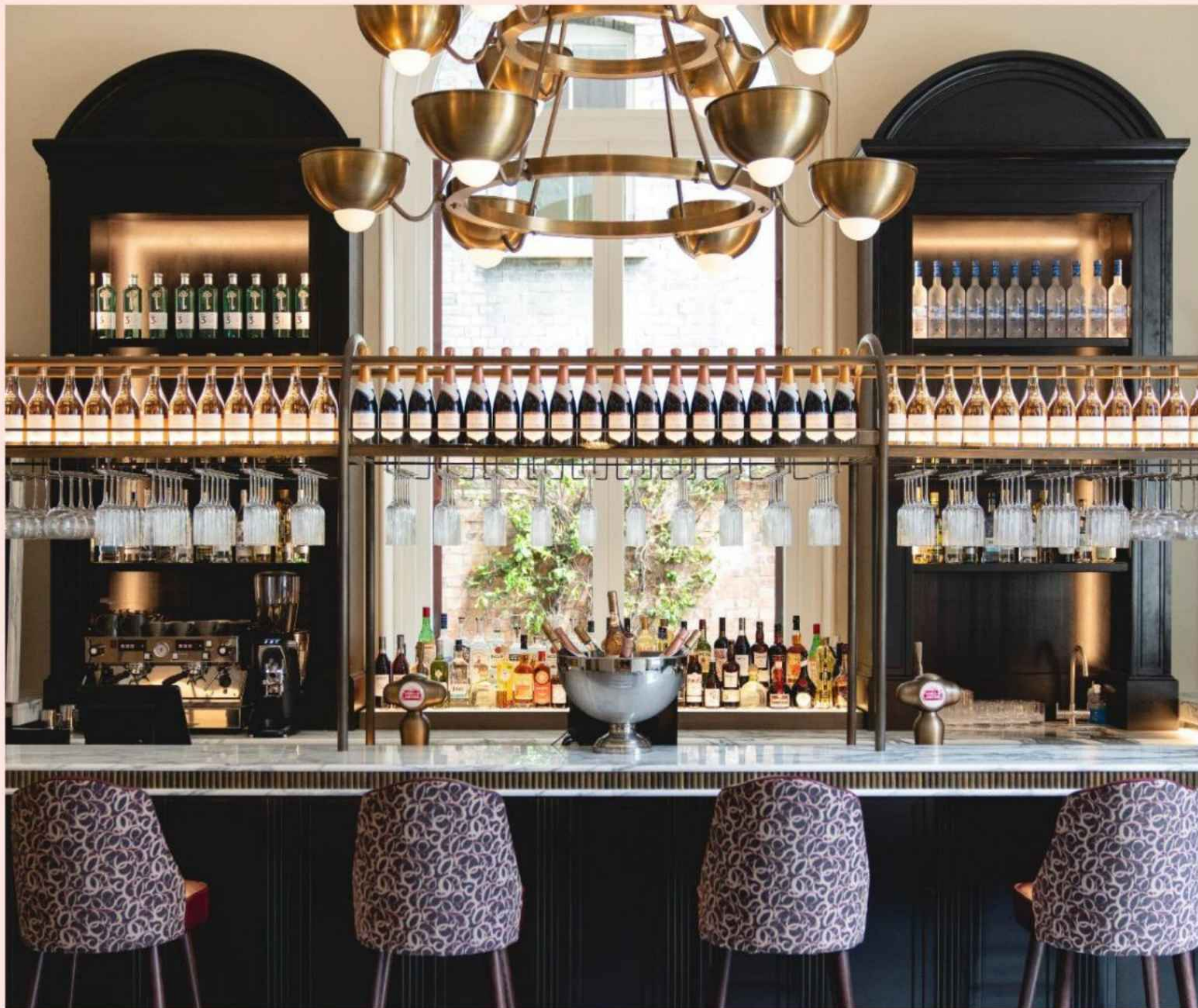
The Terrace

Connected to the Grand Saloon, the Terrace fronts the newly restored theatre, with views of both Catherine Street and Covent Garden.





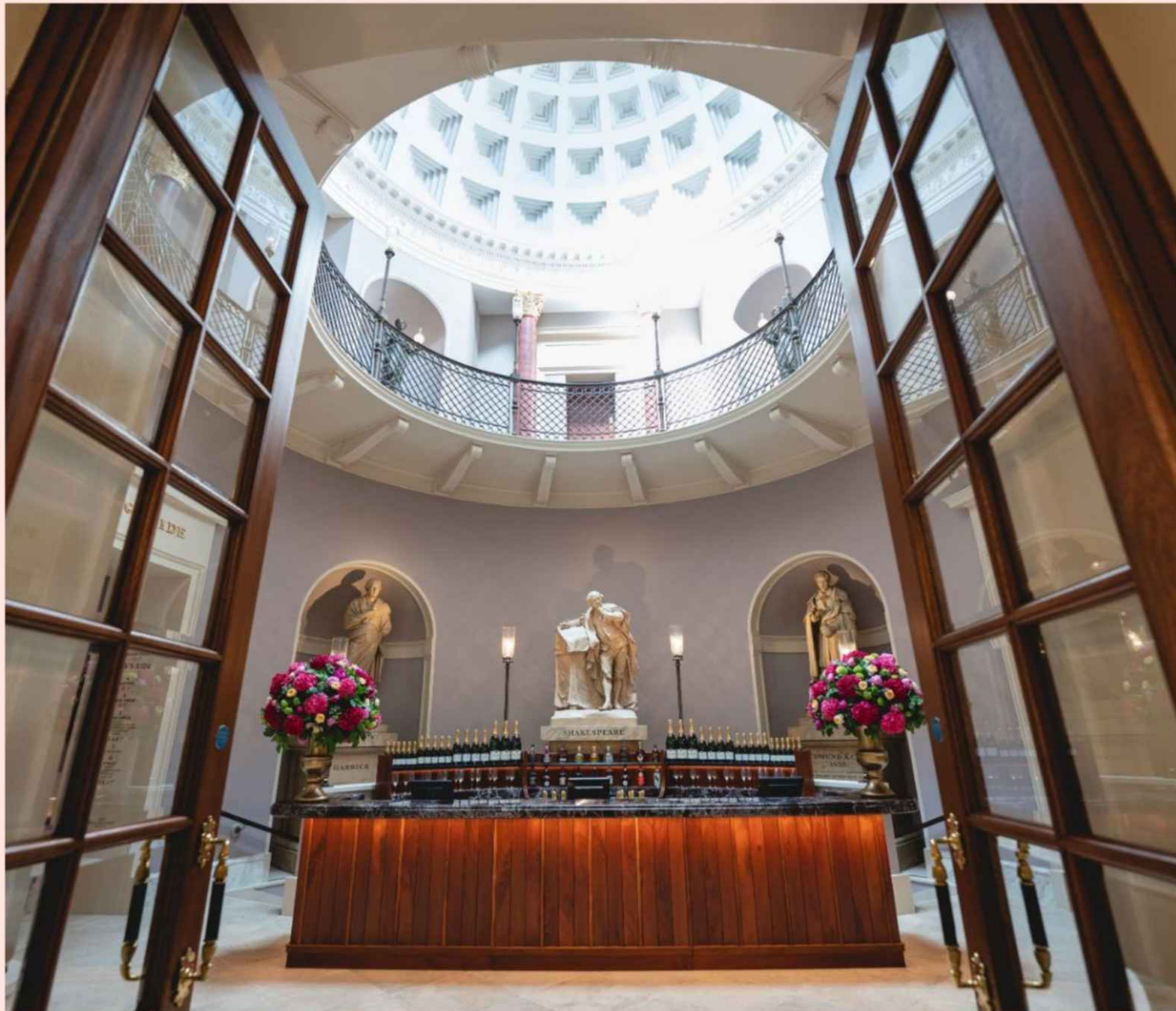
Cecil Beaton Bar & Lounge

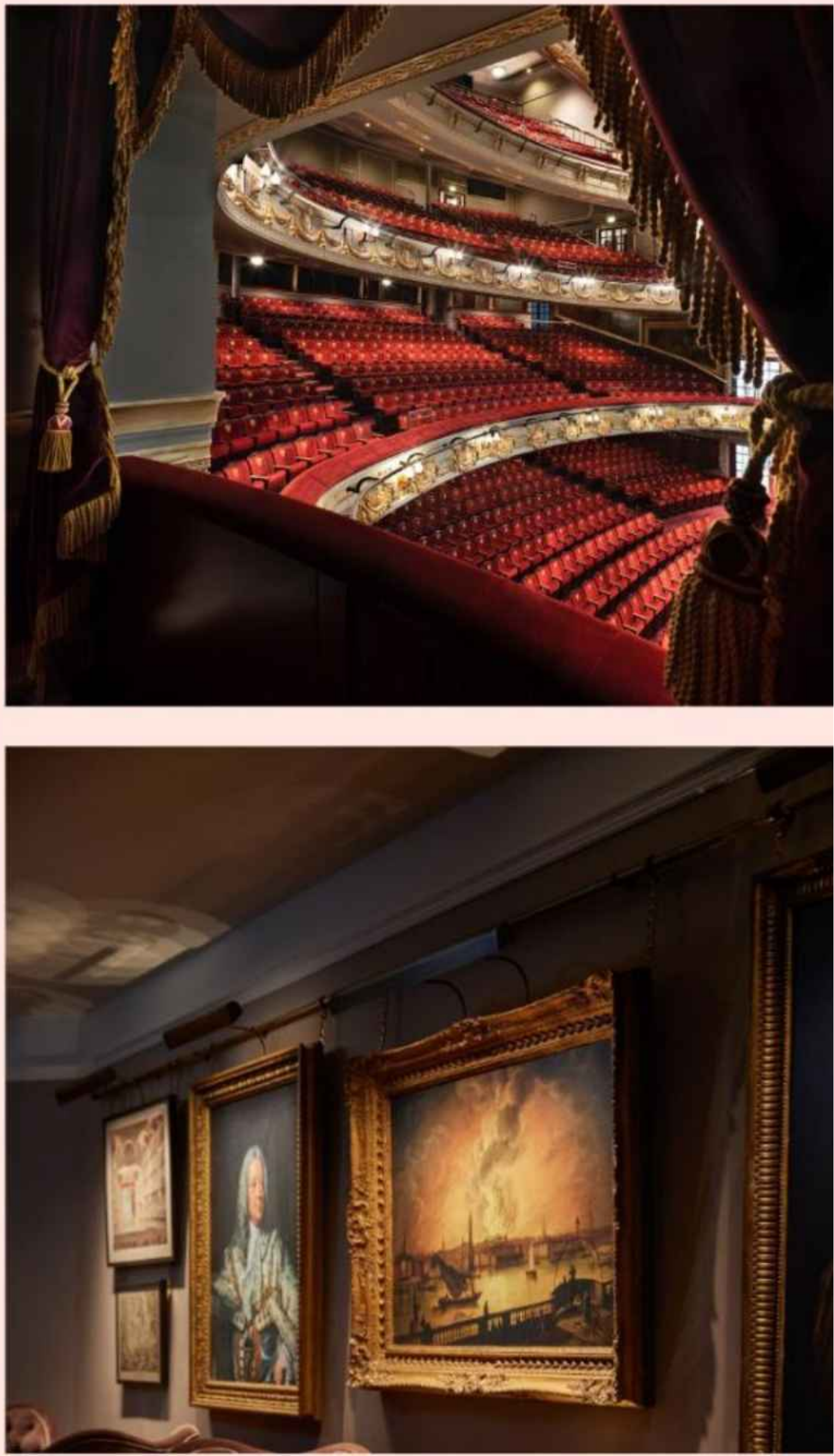


The Royal Retiring Room

Red Coat Butlers

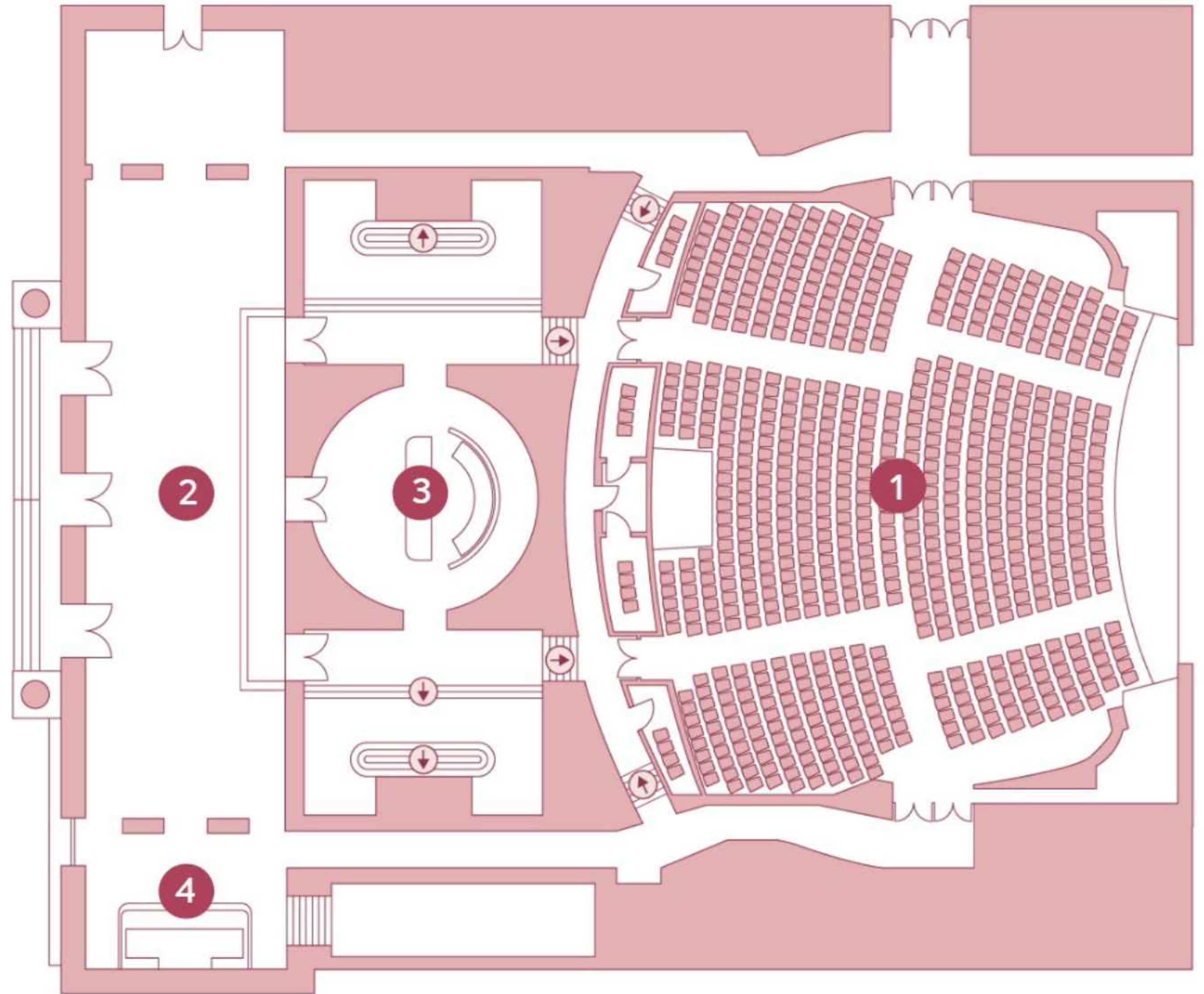
Steeped in history, the Red Coat Butler is based on the traditional Toastmasters of the past, who would oversee hosting and entertaining for the elite of British society.

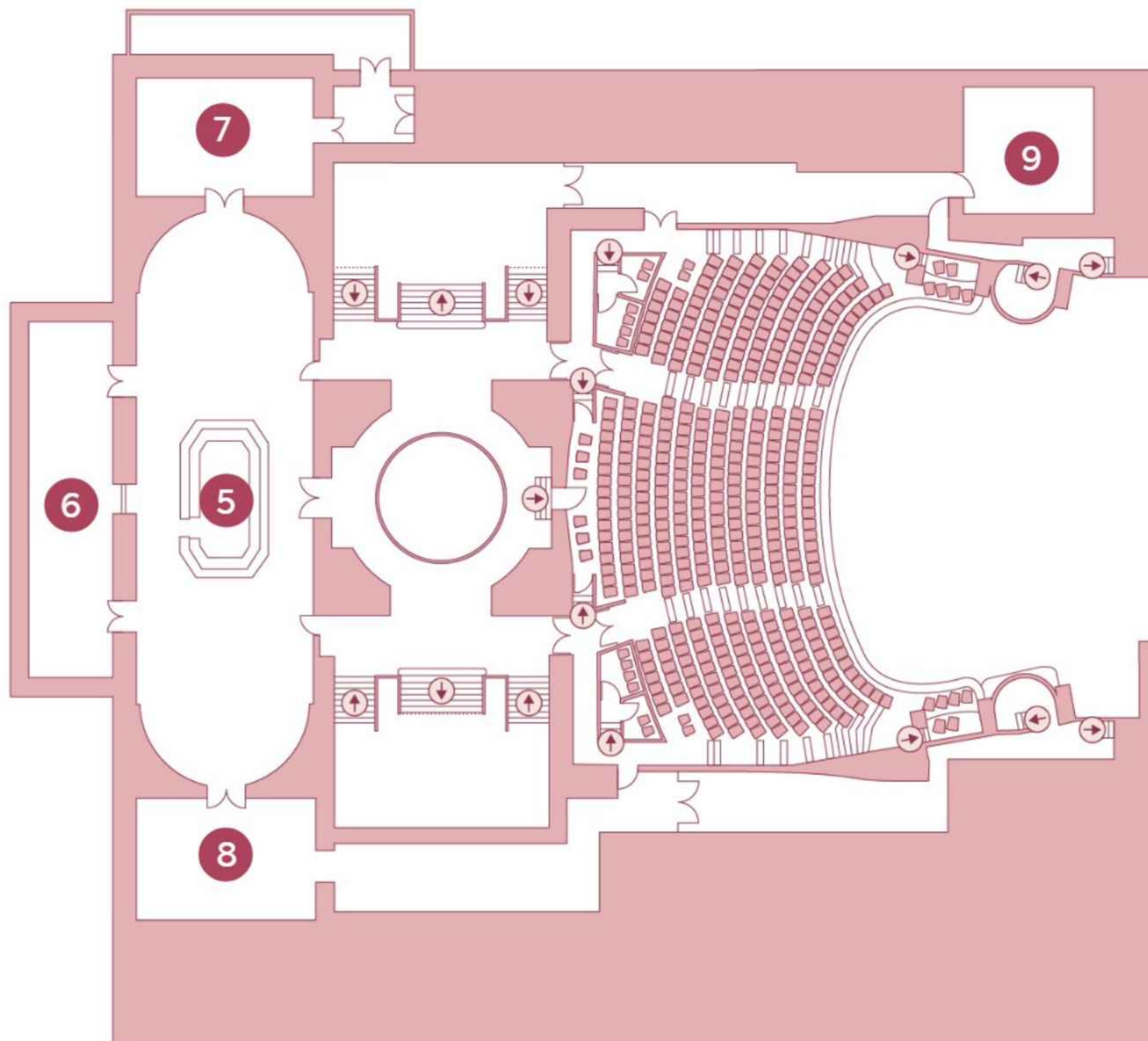
