Archery Fit

Terms and Conditions

1. General

- 1.1. This agreement, including the Schedules 1 (Rules of Shooting) and 2 (Services and Rates) attached hereto, explains the terms and conditions governing your use of the Services made available to you by Archery Fit Ltd ("Archery Fit").
- 1.2. By submitting your application form and by your use of the Services you agree to comply with all of the terms and conditions set out in this Agreement.
- 1.3. Archery Fit reserves the right to modify this Agreement at any time and any changes shall be effective upon them being posted on the Archery Fit website (http://archeryfit.com). We will try to ensure any amendments are kept to the minimum and are reasonably justified.
- 1.4. You are responsible for reading this document from time to time and checking the website for any amendments to ensure that your use of the Services remains in compliance with this Agreement.
- 1.5. Archery Fit does not hold itself out as being coaches for professional sportspersons. You cannot apply for coached lessons with an Archery Fit instructor if you are a professional sportsperson. For the avoidance of doubt, a professional sportsperson is anyone competing at Record Status Tournament level and above.
- 1.6. Only safety compliant bows are allowed as part of Archery Fit services. The use of crossbows and other weapons is strictly prohibited.

2. Services

- 2.1. Subject to making the appropriate payments and complying with this Agreement, members are permitted access to, and use of, the following:
 - 2.1.1. the shooting ranges for the purpose of practicing archery;
 - 2.1.2. the equipment needed for practicing archery;
 - 2.1.3. the bow storage facilities available for the purpose of storing bows and related equipment;
 - 2.1.4. the storage lockers available for the purpose of storing personal items and clothing
 - individually and collectively known as the "Services".
- 2.2. The Services are available to individuals aged 18 to 70 or, outside of this, at the management's discretion.
- 2.3. Young members aged between 8 and 17 may take part in the Services if accompanied and supervised by an appropriate adult.
- 2.4. The management reserves the right to close Archery Fit for up to 5 days in one calendar month.
- 2.5. The opening times are as referred to in Schedule 2 and will be displayed at the entrance of the premises or on the website, and are subject to change from time to time.

3. Personal data

3.1. Any personal information that a member provides to Archery Fit in connection with their

membership will not be disclosed by Archery Fit to any third party unless legally required and subject to clause 3.2. Archery Fit commits to complying with all data protection laws and regulations.

- 3.2. Members agree with the disclosure of their names and training session details in the online booking system operated by Archery Fit and available to other members only.
- 3.3. Archery Fit makes photos and records video in its premises. Members agree to grant to Archery Fit the right, permission, and authority to use their images, voice, and/or likeness, without compensation, in any photographs, videotapes, CD's, DVD's, broadcast, recordings, motion pictures, commercial advertisement, promotion materials, social media and/or any other record for any purpose whatsoever.

4. Service Interruption

Archery Fit reserves the right to suspend the Services at any time, for any duration of time, when necessary without penalty or liability to you and bears no responsibility whatsoever for any disruption to service. We will try to ensure these situations are kept to the minimum and are reasonably justified.

5. Limitation of Liability

- 5.1. The Services are provided on an "as is" and "as available" basis and use of the Services is at your own risk.
- 5.2. Archery Fit makes no representations or warranties, either express or implied, with respect to the service or content or information provided through the Services.
- 5.3. Archery Fit bears no responsibility for any damages, injury or economic loss arising from the use of the Services provided.
- 5.4. Unattended items kept in the bow storage facilities will be considered property of Archery Fit after an unpaid period of 1 (one) year.
- 5.5. Archery Fit will take reasonable steps to safeguard items held in the storage lockers but bears no responsibility or liability for such items. Items left in the storage lockers overnight will be disposed of after a period of 3 (three) days.

6. Indemnity

You undertake to indemnify Archery Fit against any loss or expense for any damage to the premises or its contents or equipment, whether or not owned by Archery Fit, caused by your inappropriate use of the Services.

7. Fees

- 7.1. Members agree to pay the applicable fees in accordance with Schedule 2.
- 7.2. Once the Services are booked and applicable payments made no refund is offered.

8. Termination

- 8.1. Archery Fit may terminate your membership at any time, on immediate written notice, for conduct that is in material breach of this Agreement or for conduct that Archery Fit believes to be harmful to their business or use of the Services by other members or is harmful to any third party.
- 8.2. Archery Fit reserves the right to refuse membership to any person at their sole discretion.

9. Member Obligations and Responsibilities

9.1. Members agree to:

- 9.1.1. pay the fees in accordance with clause 7;
- 9.1.2. attend the lessons / sessions at the time agreed; missed lessons / sessions (unless Archery Fit is notified at least 48 hours in advance) will count as attended and must be paid for; no refunds for cancellations under any circumstances will be given for cancellations made on the day of your lesson / session.
- 9.1.3. ensure compliance with the rules attached at Schedule 1;
- 9.1.4. ensure that they are fit and healthy and, if necessary, consult with their GP and/or other medical specialists before carrying out any activity in relation to the Services; and
- 9.1.5. comply with any instruction given by an instructor of Archery Fit.

10. Prohibited Activities

- 10.1. Members are not permitted to use the Services in the following circumstances:
 - 10.1.1. if the management believes or suspects them of being under the influence of either alcohol and/or drugs (prescription or otherwise that may impair their ability to shoot and behave safely or that may endanger others participating or observing at the range). Any such member or individual will be asked to leave the premises.
 - 10.1.2. anyone found to be or seen behaving improperly, damaging property or in an offensive manner may be asked to leave the premises.
 - 10.1.3. breaching the safety rules in Schedule 1, in particular pointing their bow at another person, whether charged or not, is strictly prohibited at all times.
 - 10.1.4. smoking at the premises (including the terraced area) is strictly prohibited at all times.
- 10.2. Any member whose behaviour does fall within the scope of sub-clause 10.1 may be asked to leave the premises and/or have their membership terminated with immediate effect.
- 10.3. For the avoidance of doubt, Archery Fit retains the right to cancel a session if any of the circumstances in 10.1 occurs, without the need to provide a refund.

11. Entire Agreement

This Agreement, including the Schedules 1 and 2 attached, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes and extinguishes any and all previous agreements, promises, assurances, warranties, representations and understandings between them, whether written or oral, relating to its subject matter.

Schedule 1

Rules of Shooting

- 1. Each member of Archery Fit has a duty to ensure that their actions do not compromise the safety of themselves or others.
- 2. Each member is doing archery at their own risk in respect of personal injuries.
- 3. No member may direct their bow towards people. It does not matter whether it is charged with an arrow or not.
- 4. No member may draw their bow, with or without an arrow, except when standing at the shooting line and after the range captain (instructor/coach/judge) allows it. Each member shall aim toward the targets but only after being satisfied that the range is clear both in front of and behind the targets.
- 5. When drawing back the string of the bow no member shall use any technique which, in the opinion of the coach, could allow the arrow to fly beyond a safety zone or safety arrangements (overshoot area, net, wall, etc.). Do not change body position once the bow is drawn. Do not draw a bow towards up and shoot up.
- 6. No member may shoot a target other than the one allocated to them.
- 7. No member may draw their bow without an arrow, except on a clear instruction of the coach. Bows will break after a single dry shot.
- 8. Members shall retire from the shooting line as soon as their last arrow has been shot.
- 9. Members shall not leave their equipment closer than 1 meter to the shooting line.
- 10. Members may go (no running) to collect arrows from the target only after the range captain (instructor/ coach/ judge) allows it. Do not enter a range in front of shooting archers.
- 11. Members shall take precautions pulling arrows from the target not to block/ injure other members.
- 12. Members shall unpin their target face and leave it in the designated place in the end of the session.
- 13. If anyone present where archery is taking place becomes aware that shooting should be halted for safety reasons, that person must call "FAST". On hearing this call, all archers must immediately stop shooting, returning all unshot arrows to the quiver. If necessary, the call of "FAST" should be repeated by other archers to ensure that everyone has heard and stopped shooting. Shooting will recommence only on the clear instruction of the coach.
- 14. No member is allowed to provide coaching at Archery Fit facilities in any form.
- 15. Members are prohibited to do archery under alcohol or drugs.
- 16. If a member feels unwell they must stop training and notify the coach.
- 17. Members shall check their equipment at all times and immediately report any defects and faults to the coach. Do not use faulty equipment.
- 18. Members shall not talk in a loud voice whilst others are shooting. Do not talk to other archers who obviously prefer to be silent. Do not make any exclamation on the shooting line that might disconcert a neighbour in the act of shooting.
- 19. No member may touch anyone else's equipment without permission.
- 20. Members and persons not involved in the shooting shall not be closer than 2 meters to the shooting line.
- 21. Members shall not leave litter.
- 22. No member may suggest using their partners and/or bosses as target stands! (although every other does)
- 23. Each member shall leave all their worries and anxieties outside the club and fully enjoy their time with Archery Fit;)
