GLASS WINE BAR — Level 2

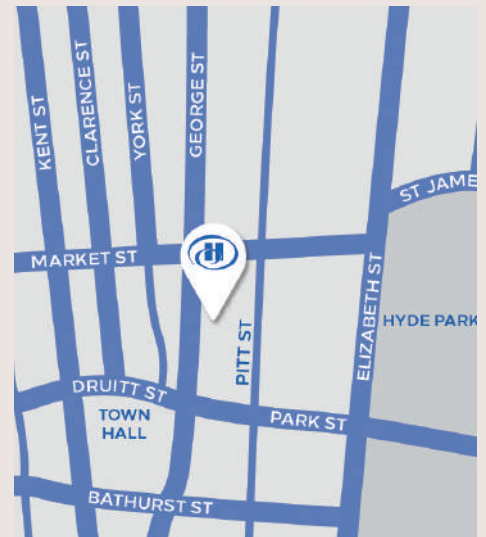
