THE WILBERFORCE ROOM

Perfect for a whole variety of daytime events, the Wilberforce Room has all of the unique charm of a 19th century warehouse, whilst being brought right up to date with an audio-visual system. This flexible event space has capacity for up to 273 seated guests.

There is direct access to the adjacent Quayside Room which provides the perfect breakout space.
