


Name: Jesse

Skill: Knows lots of people and experts






Name: Rebekah

Tips: You need a group of parents and local residents who can support and promote the benefits of the project



Find out about the air quality in your local area – you are on a busy road and think you might need to reduce traffic

Tips: You need to start by collecting data, but you don't know the methods or have any equipment to to gather information about air quality



A barrier for lots of children walking to and from school in winter is a worry about being seen in the dark. You want to create a 'high vis library' for children to borrow high vis vests, patches and stickers so they can be seen in the dark

Tips: you don't have any money to buy the clothing and you need a way of getting the message out to parents explaining how to borrow from your 'high vis library'



You want to reach the next level of STARS accreditation by starting a Junior Travel Ambassador Scheme with Year 5 and 6 to give them more control about the goals you set and the activities you run

Tips: You have some pupils already helping you but you'd like more information about how to set up the scheme, and how other schools have got pupils involved
