

NOMINATION PROCESS

World Curling Federation Board Elections, September 2021

At the Annual General Assembly of the World Curling Federation held virtually in September 2020, the members approved changes to the process of nominations for Board positions. Candidates no longer need to be nominated by their Member Association, they can be nominated by anyone or can submit their own name.

Nominations will be vetted by the Nominations Committee who will review the Nominations Forms and interview the candidates before advising the Membership that a candidate is suitable for election.

The WCF Board is a skill based Strategic Board and following a self-assessment against the attached Skills Matrix they have identified that candidates who bring skills in Marketing and Risk Management would be especially welcome.

The Nominations Committee cannot prevent a candidate's name from going forward to the election unless they are found not to be in line with the constitutional requirements for candidates. All candidates will be informed of the status of their candidature by the Nomination Committee prior to the announcement of candidates to the MA representatives. Candidates will be informed in due course on the guidelines for promotion of their candidacy to the electorate.

The positions due for election at the Annual General Assembly 2021 are Vice President Americas and Director Position 3. Hew Chalmers, who current holds Director Position 1, has indicated he will not be seeking re-election. Graham Prouse, who current hold the Vice President Americas position, has indicated he will be seeking re-election.

In addition, candidates will be asked to provide a video of no more than 5 (five) minutes in length which will be made available to the Member Associations. This video should show the candidate talking about their motivation for the position and what they will add to the work of the Board and Federation.
