# An Interactive Performance and Live Broadcast for Schools

**Project Lighthouse** is a **free educational event** for students **aged 16+**, offering a unique opportunity to engage with themes of peace, identity, community, and belonging.

Schools can take part either **in person** at the Hawk's Well Theatre or **online** through an interactive live broadcast, allowing students to connect and participate wherever they are.

Designed as an interactive three-hour journey, **Project Lighthouse** places young people's voices at its centre. The programme begins with a 45-minute interactive pre-show, followed by the live performance and concludes with a facilitated post-show discussion and reflection, giving students the opportunity to explore the themes raised and share their responses.

Whether attending in the theatre or joining online, students become part of a shared cross-community experience, contributing their own perspectives and reflections throughout the event.

Project Lighthouse is an ambitious youth-led arts project that brings young people together to explore identity, community, conflict, and the future they want to create.

Through an exchange of stories, perspectives, and artistic practice, the project opens up new ways of understanding life on a divided island – and in a divided world.

Led by the Hawk's Well Theatre, Sligo, in partnership with the Millennium Forum Theatre, Derry/Londonderry, and the John and Pat Hume Foundation, Project Lighthouse provides a platform for young people to share their experiences, question assumptions, and engage in meaningful dialogue about peace today.

A group of participants from Sligo and Derry/Londonderry will spend time living and working within each other's communities. Guided by professional theatre artists, they will explore their own identities and lived experiences before collaboratively creating an original live performance. The result will be a bold and honest piece of theatre that explores conflict, connection, understanding, and hope for the future.
