

Charge Your Trimmer

Fully charge the trimmer before you use it for the first time or after not using it for a long period (When charging, please use a power adapter with an output voltage not higher than 5V.)

When the digital display shows this indicator icon, it means the trimmer is on charge.

How to Use

Adjust the Angle of the Blade Head

One hand hold the trimmer, and use the other hand to press the blade head to toggle between the two available angles, choosing the one that best suits your grooming needs.




Remove the Protective Cover

Before usage, please remove the blade protective cover. Simply apply gentle pressure to the latch, and it will release the protective cover.

Install and the Guided Comb

Make sure the trimmer is turned off before you install or remove the guide comb.

You can install different sizes of guide combs to adjust the trimming length according to your needs.



Turn on/off

Press the power switch to turn on/off the trimmer.

Trim Your Body

After adjusting the trimming angle and attaching the guide comb, switching on the trimmer to start trim. Gently glide the blade end through your skin using slow, stroking motions.

© Care should be taken to avoid scratching your skin.

To Deactivate the Travel Lock: While in travel lock mode, press and hold the power button for another 3 seconds to release the travel lock. The device will then turn on automatically.

Cleaning & Maintenanc

- 1. Power Off and Disassemble:
- Turn off the power and unplug the device, leaving the blade section only.
- 2. Brush Away Hair:
- Use the cleaning brush to gently remove any hair from the trimmer head and the gaps between the body and the
- trimmer head. 3. Deep Clean the Trimmer Head: Use a screwdriver (not included) to unscrew the two side
- screws and remove the trimmer head and torsional spring. Clean the inside of the body with the cleaning brush. Rinse the trimmer head and spring with water, dry thoroughly, and
- reassemble in order using the screwdriver. 4. Avoid Water Exposure: Do not wipe the entire trimmer with a wet cloth to prevent damage to the electronic components.
 - Note: Always detach the trimmer head for cleaning. Do not rinse
 - the body with water, as it can damage the internal parts and make the trimmer unusable.

Safety Instruction

- Before connecting to the adapter, ensure the Type-C charging port is completely dry.
- Avoid wrapping the charging cable around the trimmer to prevent cable damage.
- Install, remove, or adjust the trimming comb and blade head while the trimmer is turned off
 - 4. Turn off and unplug the trimmer before cleaning.

 5. To prevent injuries, avoid pressing the blade teeth into the skin.

6. Immediately stop using the trimmer if it malfunctions.

Consult the troubleshooting section or contact customer service for assistance.

7. Stop using the trimmer's charging cable if it is damaged or malfunctioning.

8. Fully charge the trimmer at least once every six months if it has not been used for an extended period.
