

### **PRECAUTIONS**

- 1. Minors should use this product under adult supervision.
- 2. Wash thoroughly before first use.
- 3. Do not sterilize or clean plastic parts by boiling or exposing them to high temperatures.
- Keep away from heat sources to prevent deformation or discoloration.
- 5. Do not heat this product using a microwave or other heating devices.
- 6. Do not store carbonated beverages.
- 7. Not suitable for long-term storage of dairy products or baby food, as this may lead to bacterial growth.
- 8. Do not overfill with hot water to avoid spills and burns.
- Do not forcefully insert ice cubes larger than the cup's opening, as this may cause deformation or damage.
- 10. Avoid strong impacts to prevent dents, deformation, or breakage.
- 11. Do not scratch the cup's surface with sharp objects to avoid damage.
- 12. Ensure the lid is tightly closed when carrying to prevent leaks.
- 13. After use, tighten the lid and place the cup upright to avoid leakage.
- 14. Make sure the sealing ring is properly installed to prevent spills.

#### **USING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Straw Spout:

Pull the straw spout lock upwards, then push it back to to use.



#### Push Button:

As shown in the picture, the button is in the locked position. To open the cup cap, push the button upward and press the lower half of the button.





# **MAINTENANCE**

- To maintain product functionality and extend its lifespan, avoid impacts and scratches during use.
- Clean the cup after each use to prevent odors and ensure long-lasting performance.
- 3. Do not use gasoline, metal scouring pads, or abrasive cleaners.
- 4. Clean the exterior and lid with a sponge dipped in diluted dish detergent and warm water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- 5. Avoid soaking the cup in water for extended periods. Do not use chlorine-based cleaners or disinfectants, as they may cause rust or damage to the inner liner.
- 6. After prolonged use, dissolve baking soda in warm water and use it to clean the cup, or dilute 1–2 drops of vinegar in warm water and rinse thoroughly with warm water afterward.

Beverage is leaking	Overfilling. The lid seals are correctly set. The lid and body are securely tightened.	Don't overfill.  Ensure seals are in place.  Tighten the lid.
There is an un- pleasant odor	There is any dirt on the cup liner and lid.	Clean with warm water.
The lid seal discolors	• There is grime or mold on the product.	Use oxygen bleach to clean.     If the grime or mold does not come off, please purchase a new seal.
