We are also thankful for those who have given their time and talents lately to help with the practical work at the prayer house. Bela took time between his lectures at the university to come and dig trenches for the laying of the drainage pipes, Ferenc a plumber joined us after working hours to fix the water supply, David joined us after college to do gardening jobs and Henrik came after work at his warehouse to do any kind of labouring work needed. These are all examples and expressions of love and care from our parent church which fill our hearts with thankfulness.

We are thankful for partnership with Kilbride Presbyterian. Last summer Kilbride sent an Exodus team to join us for youth and children's work, and this year they will send a building team from April 6-11, and an exodus team in July.

We pray that our partnership in the gospel would be strengthened as the building team join us in praying for the church plant and carry out manual work on the grounds, putting in a fence and new gates to secure the Prayer House.



We will also take time for home visits, and some will join us in the annual Gypsy Mission prayer day on April 11th. Please join us in prayer for the Kilbride team, for safety, health and quick solutions to any problems we may face with the fence and gate project.
