

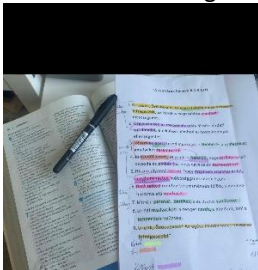

The months of May and June are usually busy with **summer preparation** and looking ahead to the wealth of opportunities for ministry with children and young people. In May we began a weekly English class in order to help prepare the young people for basic communication with the Kilbride Exodus team in July. With school finishing on 19th June we can begin preparation with our team of volunteers and our first children's bible week will be held in our parent church from June 22-26. In June Csaba and the team will continue the preparation and open registration for the National Reformed football championship which will be in August.



The Bodaszőlő **Women's Group** we have started an inductive Bible study series in the Psalms and are encouraged as we look at different methods and tools to help us dig deeper into the Word, discover the context, what it meant to its original audience and apply the truths to our own lives and situations. We enjoyed a presbytery women's day in May at our parent church where 1 Corinthians 5, 16-17 was the focus for talks, praise, discussions and a prayer walk based on the wordless book.



In June we will continue our studies in the Psalms. We plan to have a short outing together in June and will also meet together to begin making apricot jam and elderflower syrup for use during the Bodaszőlő children's bible week and youth week, both in July.

June 2026

In May, we continued with some minor work in the small room of the **Prayer House**, plastering and painting, and some work in the garden. We received a donation of tomato and paprika plants and so planted a small community garden at the rear of the property. We hope that if there is a good harvest, we will be able to make preserve of 'lecsó' a type of vegetable stew which can be given to families in need in the autumn and winter. At the moment we are waiting on the funding to come through so we can begin work creating the bathroom. Until this is complete, we can't really use the Prayer House for meetings.

In May we rejoiced together with Dani, David and Francseszka, who were baptised and confirmed. It was encouraging to hear their personal testimonies and a great time of thanksgiving for the work of God's spirit in their hearts.
