With thankful hearts, in mid-October we managed to finalize the purchase of the property in Vinceller street in Bodaszóló and the parent-church building committee got to work straight away on evaluating the situation and planning the renovations for our little church hall. We are so thankful for our parent church at Calvin square, for their focussed prayer and generous hearts of love and service for the community in Bodaszóló.

A team got to work straight away clearing the garden, pulling out the vines and cutting trees and bushes. It has been a tremendous blessing to see many have given generously to the purchase of the property, and others offering their time and expertise. One elder who is an electrician will rewire the whole house free of charge. Another who has an insulation business is donating insulation material, and many others have offered practical work or building materials. It will take us some time to get the building ready, so we will keep using the rented buildings in the village until the spring.

The women’s group are nearing the end of our series on the fruit of the spirit and we have enjoyed some lively and challenging discussions. It is great to see more of the women find their voice in group prayer and encouraging to see their heart to serve in the community. We have already started to make Macrame coasters for a Christmas gift for the elderly in the village.

In November we will take a group of 17 to the Reformed church gypsy mission annual weekend conference. We are looking forward to a time of good teaching, praise and worship with gypsy mission members and leaders from around the country and pray this will be a great time of blessing for the fellowship.



This autumn, during home visits we have had an increase in the number of elderly people asking the church-plant for financial help to pay for their medication. Rising costs mean some are forced to make the choice between food or their necessary medication. As we did last year, in late November, the church-plant will have a three-day food bank collection in our nearby Aldi, so we can make up Christmas food parcels for elderly who struggle with food insecurity.
