Dear Friends and Prayer Supporter

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We want to thank you sincerely for your continued prayers, encouragement, and support as we continue the work of re-establishing a Presbyterian witness here in Wexford. We are deeply grateful for those who stand alongside us in prayer and partnership, and we want to share a brief update on how the Lord is continuing to lead and provide.

Over the last number of months, we have made steady progress with the refurbishment of the church building. The building is now finished and been transformed in a welcoming and usable space for worship, fellowship and outreach, not just for us, but use within the community as well, we are so thankful for all the ways God has provided for us.

We continue to meet weekly for service, and we are encouraged by the faithfulness of those gathering with us each Sunday, we regularly have new people join us to see what we are all about. Alongside this, our home group continues to be an important time of Bible study, prayer and fellowship, as we seek to grow together in Christ.



One highlight over the past few months was our Service of Rededication, held in April. We were greatly encouraged by the wonderful attendance with the church building filled by members of our congregation, visitors, friends and supporters from near and far. It was a special occasion as we gave thanks to God for his faithfulness and

committed the building and ministry afresh to His service.

The gathering was a tremendous encouragement not only to us but also to those who regularly worship with us. Seeing the church so full served as a reminder of God's goodness and of the wider fellowship of believers who share in the vision of establishing a vibrant Presbyterian witness in Wexford.



Another significant development has been the installation of our AV system, we are so thankful for this provision, which will greatly assist in worship services, ministry opportunities, and future outreach as the work develops.

As we look ahead to the summer months, we are planning a children's ministry outreach into one of the local housing estates with the help from a team from America. We pray that this will be a joyful and welcoming opportunity to connect with families in our community, and that many young people will hear the good news of Jesus Christ. We would also appreciate prayer for our son, Joshua, as he prepares to take part in a mission trip to Grand Island, Nebraska, where he will join a team of young people from Northern Ireland to serve in a Holiday Bible Club and other outreach activities for ten days. Following their time in the US the team will return to Northern Ireland before travelling on to minister at Holiday Bible Clubs in both Fivemiletown and Wexford.
