Advent in Narnia

In recent years a number of churches have organised Advent and Christmas worship services, as well as special family events, based on the much-loved Chronicles of Narnia by C S Lewis.

Global interest in the books is likely be renewed with Netflix's film adaptation of *The Magician's Nephew* in cinemas from 10 February 2027. The film features an all-star cast and includes Belfast teenager David McKenna as Digory, which is likely to generate local interest. The Magician's Nephew although written later is the first book in the series and explains how Narnia was born.

Suggested Bible Texts: Isaiah 40:5; Psalm 98; John 1:1–18; Luke 2:1–16; Philippians 2:5–11

Theme: The King Arrives Among Us

Narnia: Meeting Aslan

New Year's Eve

Suggested Bible Text: Romans 13:8–14

Theme: A Debt of Love and the Armor of Light

Narnia: Aslan's battle, statues revived, Edmund's restoration
