Sunday 7 June

- **General Assembly 2026** | *'Dear friend, you are faithful in what you are doing for the brothers and sisters, even though they are strangers to you'. 3 John 1:5. In this week of General Assembly, give thanks for our denominational family. Pray for a sense of God's presence in PCI congregations meeting to worship God all over Ireland today.*
- **Council for Training in Ministry** | *Pray for the Council convener, Rev Andrew Faulkner, and the Principal of Union Theological College, Prof Michael McClenahan, as they present the report of the Council. Give thanks for the wide-ranging work of the Council, which impacts the whole denomination. Pray that decisions taken by the Assembly will bear fruit in lives across Ireland.*

Monday 8 June

- **Moderator** | *Pray for the Moderator, Rt Rev Dr Richard Murray, as he prepares to lead the first part of the General Assembly before stepping down from office. Give thanks for his dedication, resilience and leadership in what have been challenging times for the denomination. Pray for a period of rest and refreshment before he resumes his ministry full-time in the congregation of Drumreagh.*
- **Council for Global Mission** | *Give thanks for the six overseas delegates attending this year's Assembly from five countries. Pray that they will experience a warm welcome and feel at home among us, not least as they share in the Partners' Fellowship Meal at lunchtime today. Pray that they will both know and bring blessings and encouragement in the week ahead.*

Tuesday 9 June

- **Council for Social Witness** | *Pray for Rev David Brice, convener, and Caroline Yeomans, Interim Director of the Council for Social Witness as they report on behalf of the Council for Social Witness to the General Assembly today. In the midst of complex decisions and urgent needs, pray for David and Caroline and all of the Council for Social Witness staff team.*
- **Council for Mission in Ireland** | *This evening, the Council for Mission in Ireland will present its report to the General Assembly. Give thanks for the Council's work in supporting mission across Ireland through church planting, Home Mission congregations and the ministry of chaplaincy, as well as various mission projects and personnel. Pray for the Council's proposed developments and ongoing work.*

Wednesday 10 June

- **Council for Public Affairs** | *Pray for Rev Daniel Kane and Dr Bex Stevenson as they prepare for General Assembly, pray that their reports will be both informative and impactful, providing good insights into the work of the Council. Pray also for those who hear these reports, that they will engage with it and that they will develop a passion and interest in this vital missional work of engaging in the public square.*
- **Council for Global Mission: Listening to the Global Church** | *Pray for overseas delegates as they are invited to speak about the challenges and opportunities encountered in the mission of PCI's partner churches in Spain, Lebanon and Kenya. Pray that those who attend this session will be given 'ears to hear' what God might be saying, and be strengthened in their faith that He "is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine" in advancing his Kingdom purposes.*

Thursday 11 June

- **Council for Global Mission** | *Pray that through the presentation and debate of the Council for Global Mission report this morning, God's heart for PCI's denominational engagement in global mission would be very evident, not least the extent to which PCI should continue to be a 'sending' church. Pray that the tenor of the debate would set in motion ripples of encouragement throughout the Council, the Mission Dept staff team, and especially PCI's global mission workers currently serving in the name of Christ beyond the shores of Ireland.*
- **General Council** | *The General Council will report on several areas this afternoon, such as communications and United Appeal, amongst a number of others. Pray for those bringing the reports, that they will be able to convey with clarity and grace their reports and for those listening to be granted understanding and insight.*

Friday 12 June

- **Council for Mission in Ireland** | *This week, the General Assembly considered a report from the Council for Mission in Ireland plans regarding the South West of Ireland. The report outlined priorities focused on strengthening existing congregations in the area and exploring new mission opportunities in the city of Limerick. Pray for the practical outworking of this report in the coming months.*
- **Council for Mission in Ireland** | *Give thanks for the office-bearers of the Council for Mission in Ireland who delivered its report to the General Assembly this week. Pray particularly for Council convener, Rev Dr Ben Walker and Council Secretary, Rick Hill, that God would guide them in their ongoing work.*

Saturday 13 June

- **General Council** | *Pray for the outworking of all decisions taken at General Assembly, that they might be implemented faithfully and wisely. Remember Rev Dr Richard Kerr as he commences his year as Moderator, that he will know God's guiding and the inspiration of the Holy Spirit in the year ahead.*
- **Council for Global Mission** | *Give thanks for the staff and volunteers who have worked so hard to ensure Assembly week was a time of upbuilding fellowship and envisioning for global mission engagement. Pray that overseas delegates would experience safe and trouble-free journeys home over this weekend, and be able to reflect and recount with glad hearts on their time with us.*
