Sunday 12 July

- **Moderator** | *Pray for the work of the Church Leaders which continues over the summer months. Ask that this group of leaders will be faithful representatives as they engage in representing the voice of the Church in the public square regarding sometimes complex and sensitive issues.*
- **Resting in God in worship** | *'The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul.' Psalm 23:1-3. Thank God for how he leads us into rest that renews our souls and ask that you may find refreshment for daily living.*

Monday 13 July

- **Volker and JinHyeog Glissmann, global mission workers, Malawi** | *Praise God for the recent graduation of 66 TEE (Theological Education by Extension) learners from five different courses, for the training of future facilitators of TEE and for the growing interest in learning about the Christian faith. Please pray for Volker and JinHyeog as they return to N. Ireland on home assignment and especially as they say goodbye to many friends after 16 years in Malawi.*
- **The Evangelical Christian Church of Halmahera (GMIH), Indonesia** | *Pray for preparations for the Extraordinary Synod Assembly due to take place from 23 – 26 July as it celebrates fruitful progress towards reconciliation and the renewed unity of GMIH. Pray that this progress would be sustained in the coming year as GMIH moves towards the appointment of one, united leadership body at the next Synod Assembly in 2027.*

Tuesday 14 July

- **Fahan** | *Give thanks for the ongoing witness of this congregation, even in its ongoing vacancy. Pray for the 'Connect week' outreach from 12-19 July, in partnership with a team from Ballysally Presbyterian Church. Pray also that a new minister would be identified in the coming months to minister in Fahan and give a lead to the West Inishowen Mission Project.*
- **Toni Bassett, community outreach worker, West Belfast Special Ministry** | *West Belfast is a busy place over the summer so please pray for the plans to connect with the community during Féile and the Fleadh through walking tours and musical events as well as weekly services. Praise God for the new people who have found a home in the weekly Sunday services.*

Wednesday 15 July

- **Neil and Jenny Stewart, global mission workers, Spain** | *Give thanks for progress in language learning and pray that this would be sustained in the coming months. Pray for Neil as he seeks to forge meaningful connections with other reformed churches and ministry partners, and that the Stewart family would be blessed with ever deepening relationships and friendships.*
- **Refugees** | *Sudan is experiencing what is currently the world's largest displacement crisis, with 4.3 million refugees having fled to neighbouring countries. Pray for an end to the conflict, that people may begin to return to their homes, and for the provision of basic humanitarian assistance for Sudanese refugees spread across the region.*

Thursday 16 July

- **Galway, Rev Helen Freeburn** | *Give thanks for church family and for recent gatherings that have helped deepen friendships and faith. Pray the Lord will guide in their outreach with kids, youth and student ministries this summer and autumn. Pray for strengthening of faith and for workers in the harvest field here. Pray also for considerations of a future building project.*
- **Rev Graeme Orr, Ulster University, Magee** | *Pray for lasting fruit in the ongoing Thursday morning outreach when Graeme returns to campus in September. Pray for the growing CU and the new CU Committee as they reach out to freshers and invite other students to CU events during Welcome Week (16 - 20 September).*

Friday 17 July

- **General Council** | *Pray for the new Clerk of the General Assembly – Rev Jonathan Boyd – who will be taking up his post this incoming week. Remember him and his family as they make arrangements to relocate and as Jonathan takes up new responsibilities at this critical time in the life of PCI.*
- **Training in Ministry** | *The Union College building is historic and a significant landmark in the city of Belfast, however, it needs substantial maintenance and management. Pray for Alan McCormick, the Head of Operations at Union; the Custodian, John Piper; and the Finance Personnel and Administration Panel, as they oversee the maintenance and management of the property.*
