Sunday 19 July

- **Moderator** | *Pray for the Moderator as he makes final preparations for his overseas trip to Zimbabwe. Pray that all arrangements put in place will go smoothly and that there will be safety at all times as he and his wife, Brenda, embark on the visit.*
- **Worship throughout the year: Prayer for the preacher** | *Give thanks for those whom God has gifted to open God's Word in preaching each week. Ask that he will help them to do so with faithfulness and in a form which readily speaks into our lives today.*

Monday 20 July

- **Edwin and Anne Kibathi, global mission workers, UK** | *Pray for Edwin and Anne as they continue to visit and give leadership to the PCEA UK Outreach congregations. Pray that God would grant them wisdom and strength as they participate in a range of events, including conferences, retreats and BBQs, scheduled for these summer months. Pray that in all these activities, God's name would be glorified and the gospel shared.*
- **Presbyterian Church of Myanmar (PCM)** | *Pray for the PCM minister and his congregation who last month had to flee from their homes in Khampat due to airstrikes and bombing. Pray that God would comfort the relatives of those who remained and lost their lives in the fighting. Pray that there will be an end to the conflict in this area and that the displaced will be able to return to their homes very soon.*

Tuesday 21 July

- **Carlow and Athy (vacant)** | *Pray for the congregations of Carlow and Athy during this time of vacancy. May they continue to be a presence in these areas. Give thanks for all who join to worship.*
- **Chris Brown, community outreach worker, First Antrim** | *Give thanks for the work in which Chris is involved. Pray that he would be strengthened and encouraged as he builds relationships in the congregation and community.*

Wednesday 22 July

- **Naomi Leremore, global mission worker, Kenya** | *Give thanks for all who are deepening their knowledge and understanding of the Bible through study on the PCEA Theological Education by Extension (TEE) Programme. Pray for Naomi and her family, that they would know refreshment and encouragement during these summer months of home assignment. Pray for Naomi as she prepares to engage in deputation meetings during September.*
- **Theological Education by Extension, Malawi (TEEM)** | *Give thanks for the work of TEEM, especially Rev Chuma Njabili, Acting TEEM Director, and also a lecturer in the Department of Practical Theology at Zomba Theological University. Pray that God would grant him grace to juggle all his responsibilities and provide effective leadership for TEEM so that it may be a source of learning and encouragement for many in pastoral roles.*

Thursday 23 July

- **Sonya Anderson, deaconess, Shore Street, Donaghadee** | *Pray that God would give rest and refreshment to those who have served faithfully in children's and adult ministry throughout the year. Pray that God would speak to people as they spend time in the little church garden this summer - the theme is Psalm 23.*
- **Westbourne, Rev Mervyn Gibson** | *Pray for Rev Mervyn Gibson and the elders and members of this congregation, that they would be blessed and encouraged in their continued witness in the area.*

Friday 24 July

- **General Council** | *Pray for the staff at Assembly Buildings – many of whom will be taking their annual break with their families over the next few weeks. Pray for times of refreshment and rest and safe travel for those going further afield.*
- **Training in Ministry – Pastoral care of ministers and their families** | *Pray for ministers as they take leave and benefit from the quieter church life of the summer. Pray for refreshment and renewed energy and vision from the Lord as they also prepare for the new church year.*

Saturday 25 July

- **Tritonville Close** | *Lord Jesus, we give thanks for Tritonville Close, sheltered accommodation in Dublin, for each person who lives there and for those who offer care and support. We place this community into your loving hands. May all who live and work there know that they are held in your constant care.*
- **Hospitality** | *Pray for the safety of those who work in the food and hospitality industry across the island of Ireland, which can be particularly busy over the summer months. Pray for the owners of these businesses as they balance rising costs and staffing challenges.*
