Sunday 21 June

- **Moderator** | *Pray for the service taking place at Enniskillen PC on Sunday afternoon and its minister, Rev Steve Kennedy. The Moderator, Rev Dr Richard Kerr, will be leading the service as the congregation celebrates 350 years of witness in Enniskillen. Give thanks for the ministry and mission of the congregation over that time.*
- **Resting in God in worship** | *'Come to me, all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.' Matthew 11:28. Give thanks for Christ's invitation to find rest in him and ask for his peace to settle on your heart as you worship today.*
