Sunday 26 July

- **Moderator** | *Pray for the safety of the Moderator, Dr Richard Kerr, and his wife Mrs Brenda Kerr, as they continue their overseas trip to Zimbabwe. Pray that all their social engagements and meetings with other church leaders and community groups, would be productive and beneficial.*
- **Worship throughout the year: Pray for those who lead praise** | *Give thanks for those whom God has gifted to lead praise each week. Ask that he will help them to do so with beauty and joy.*

Monday 27 July

- **Csaba and Ilona Veres, global mission workers, Hungary** | *Give thanks for encouraging bi-weekly inductive Bible studies in the Psalms that have been taking place with the women.
