
## CÉLINE'S HORNPIPE (4/4 Time)

Céline learned this dance when she was a child in Donegal, from Séamus Kerrigan, a dancing teacher who was based in Derry. Séamus traveled along the north coast of Donegal, on behalf of Conradh na Gaeilge, and taught a class in a hall in Gortahork, in the late 1930s, close to Céline's home. She liked to dance it to hornpipes such as "The Boys of Bluehill" or "Off to California".


A comfortable dancing tempo would be in the region of 34 bars per minute.
