

NRSWA Unit O1

Signing, Lighting and Guarding

The NRSWA Unit O1 course for operatives will teach you how to safely put up signs, lights, and barriers at roadwork sites. You must be qualified to the NRSWA standards to do this work. Training was made mandatory for anyone who works on the highways to make sure drivers, pedestrians and those working on the road are safe around the construction areas.

You will learn how to:

- Produce plan of intended site showing position of signs, guarding & traffic signals. Plan must include all relevant distances, sizes and dimensions required.
- Produce list of equipment for intended site
- Demonstrate sequence of setting out the advance signing, safety zones & pedestrian walkways
- Demonstrate positioning, testing, adjusting, commissioning and decommissioning of temporary traffic signals
- Answer a range of questions to demonstrate knowledge of subject
- Conduct activities safely wearing appropriate safety wear
- Provide sufficient evidence of knowledge by way of oral or written questions

Assessment

You will complete an assessment which is made up of 20 multiple-choice questions and you will have a total of 45-minutes to answer them.

You will pass this NRSWA unit if you achieve a score of 80% or more (a minimum of 16/20).

Streetworks cards are valid for 5 years. If your card expires you are no longer qualified to set out signing, lighting and guarding on the highways.

You can take a reassessment course before your card expires and up to 5 years after the expiry date.
