

2023 onwards – Quarterly Themes

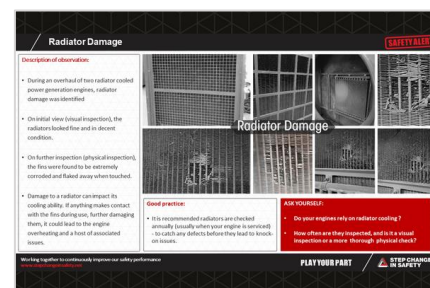
