HCT-NDRRMC clusters coordination

The meeting of the HCT and NDRRMC clusters postponed to end of February.

Priorities for HCT:

- To define the leadership and co-leadership roles and rules of engagement with Government for all clusters
- To define the role of the HCT and clusters when there is no request for international assistance, hence in national responses
- Develop / update jointly the contingency plans

HCT-NDRRMC clusters coordination

Next steps:

- OCHA will organize and facilitate a 'reflection' workshop with ICCG and NDRRMC to define the rules of engagement and then develop a Framework of HCT coordination with Government.
- Cluster FPs to wait developing contingency plans for the time being, as the coordination mechanism has to be defined with Government through the above.

HCT workplan gaps 2018

OCHA briefed HCT participants on the year-end accomplishments and remaining gaps in its 2018 work plan:

1. effective use of the HRRO format to identify humanitarian needs, cluster responses and mobilize resources;
2. improved engagement with national NGOs and the private sector both in and outside the HCT;
- 3. the updating or exercising of contingency plans for hydro-meteorological, seismic and conflict events;**
4. the endorsement of a protection strategy; and
5. progress in addressing sexual exploitation and abuse matters.
