<b>2. RESETTLEMENTS IN SUSSUNDENGA DISTRICT.</b>	<b>Action proposed</b>	<b>Responsavel</b>
<b>RESETTLEMENT LIST :</b> - DPOPHRH / SDPI share the excel list of the 26 resettlement places in 15/05/2019, see <b>Annex 3</b> ( nº 1 to nº 26) and 7 comunidades (nº 27 to nº 33) in Sussudenga district that was not affected by flooding and therefore didnt move for her place or origien, but SDPI declare in need. <b>All the 26 resettlements places and 7 communities have WATSAN support but only 7 have shelter support. SC will pass this information to partners in Beira.</b> - SDPI (Mr Jamusse) is updating this list with the numbers of HH (right now jsut the 4 first comunidades ) and the progress in setting up the plots (right now the ones marked with the small diagonal). See Annex 1 - <b>Wash Cluster</b> (out of meeting) inform that beside the HH indicated on the list, there is HH living in the surrounding of the resellements . Mr Jamusse (out of meeting ) clarifie that this families (some of the lost their house, some of them not) are included in the list in the colons J and K and Wash support is assisting all of them as they are in need. <b>VULNERABILITIES :</b> SDPI inform that the resettlement locations are the ones where the people run away from the floding and the selection criteria for them was to doble check with the community leader that the location was not floaded in other ocasions. It doesnt exist a risk/danger assesment. SC is concerned about the election of this places that is some cases are quite close from the river and ask the gouvernement (DPOPHRH / SDPI) is they need technical support in defining this areas. It is agreed that this suport will be very useful.  Wan, from IOM, inform that the can give this support in Site Planning and in risk mapping for the resettlement locatoins, as they did in Sofala before. SDPI inform that to carry out the job they need suport with fuel, working clothes (boots, catanas, etc) and at least 4 tents to overnight in the very remote comunidades. IOM will check if they can support that. GRC representatif in the country (out of meeting) with large site planning experience in MOZ highlight the importance of Site planning support to ensure the spaces for equipments (streets, schools, church, etc) are included and the existing big vegetation is included and not cutted. SC and IOM visited on 17/05 two of the resettlement places, Muwawa e Unidade that received shelter suport. See annex 2.	prepare the work planing (one team could be deployed in Manica for 1 week, ie)	
<b>POPULATION RESETTLEMENT</b> SPDI stated that all the accomodation centers are already closed and all the population moved to the new places of resettlements. SC insist on the need to provide the resettlement locations with the mininal services as water (that is confirmed in all the 33 places), schools, health center, machambas, etc. SDPI said that the machambas are very closed from the resettlement places.

<b>DPOHRH:</b> DPOHRH presented the plans for a 42m2 typologie house, however they add that given that Manica has a hight sismic level, it will be necessary to add an structure(columns and beam). Save the children offers technical suport for structural calculations. SC ask DPOHRH share the antisismic regulations in the country as well the BoQ of their proposal.	Share BoQ.
