Implementing Partners' Selection Process

1. Process for the selection of partners to implement certain activities of the BHA proposal

- A Global Update is sent to all Global Shelter Cluster (GSC) partners asking for Project Partner proposals to participate in the implementation of certain activities of the BHA grant. The following documents are to be sent along with the Global Update:
 - A summary of the activities to be implemented by GSC partners, and the criteria for the selection of partners for each activity.
 - A Project Proposal template for partners to describe the activity they seek funding for and justify how they fulfill the criteria set by the GSC.
- GSC partners interested in the implementation of these activities shall submit the Expressions of Interest Excel document with the list of activities they are requesting funding for, and a Project Proposal for those activities, justifying how they fulfill the criteria set by the GSC.
- The GSC Support Team will compile all expressions of interest and prepare an evaluation grid for the Selection committee to evaluate and score each proposal.
- A Selection committee composed of IFRC staff and volunteer SAG members will convene to analyze the Project Partner proposals and decide which GSC partner implements which activities.

9	Start of Project implementation	1 April 2021
10	End of Project implementation	The latest by 30 September 2022.
