1. Welcome brief review of the previous minutes

- Attendees were welcomed; the previous minutes were reviewed and endorsed.

2. Brief from the Cluster and Security Update

Security Situation

Unity State: The indicators were that SPLA is controlling Leer but not sure, on the other hand today we learned that IO is in Leer but there is no information for how long. There's been a build-up of troops in Lakes; there is a possibility of attack on Panyijar. There was shelling near Rubkona on the 27th and it is believed that there are some youth doing cattle raiding and clashing with SPLA. UNMISS visited Guit County and reported that all the tukuls have been burnt between Bentiu and Guit but the area remains empty of civilians. There were some shooting reported in Mayendid and Rumbek.

Upper Nile: WFP still pushing for flights to Malakal; they had a recovery flight today but obviously it is cancelled. Sporadic shelling was reported in Malakal (Doleib Hills) and Wau Shilluk and Bunj. UNDSS is still trying to get in contact with the forces controlling Malakal (believe that Olony's forces/IO is in control). On June 28th in Akoka there was some shelling, there are rumors that Olony is pursuing SPLA forces north. In Melut there was also some shelling, it is predicted that the conflict in this area will intensify in the coming days. Today we learned that there has already been some movement of IO in Melut. Last night Olony forces were shooting in the Malakal PoC into the new extension and 1 person was killed and 7 were injured (1 in critical condition). UNMISS deployed troops on the ground to support the people. Partners on the ground are working on the access in Wau Shilluk, still there is no access

Jonglei: On the 27th of June an UNMISS barge was attacked by SPLA

Central Ectoria, Warrap, Western Ectoria and Lakes: No major security issues were reported.

Partners in the UN Protection of Civilians sites: The process of prioritization of Partners is still ongoing. At this stage, Clusters are being asked to identify the number and names of Partner agencies working in the PoCs with the goal of rationalizing the number of humanitarian staff in each site. The Shelter NFI Cluster will not be as affected as others as the number of Partners is already reasonable and justifiable.

Emergency Response-Survival kit: In cooperation with other agencies and Clusters, the S-NFI cluster has pre-packed 3,000 survival kits in Rumbek and is continuing to move stock from Juba for pre-positioning and packing of additional kits. The survival kit operation is ongoing in areas that have been identified as high risk for traditional response methodologies, and where there are limited windows of opportunity for life-saving interventions. To date, Partners have sent 4,277 kits to areas in Southern Unity and operations are ongoing. Partners on the ground are working to identify locations where similar windows of opportunity for intervention exist and the Cluster remains on standby to support the operation out of Rumbek.

from the CHF and SRP partners to have the full picture on the SRP implementation so far, level of funding expenditures and also the levels of funds rise and so forth. In more specifics:

- Yesterday the **CHF partners** have received an email for sending to the cluster the level of expenditures as of 30 June 2015. For the ones that were not able to send it please send it within today.
- Also yesterday **the SRP** partners have received one email on the actual secured funding to cover Frontline-Mobile teams response, until when Frontline-Mobile teams response are covered and the amount of money secured as of now (The total funds raised against SRP)

4. Briefing by locations

Jongley:

- **Akobo West (Jonglei) – SCI, INTERSOS, Nile Hope:** Distribution for IDPs from Pajut finalized on June 30-Jul 1st and 730 HHs were assisted with NFIs;
- **Waat (Nyiröl) – SCI, INTERSOS, PAH:** Needs verification and registration for 302HHs completed;
- **Motot (Jonglei) – Intersos, SCI and PAH:** Registration of 1733 families completed. There is currently a discussion ongoing with Tearfund on the way forward for NFI distribution;
- **Nyandin, Fangak (Jonglei) – Medair:** Assessment, registration, and verification are complete; modalities of transportation and distribution of NFIs are under discussion;
- **Keew (Jonglei) – IOM:** An IRNA was conducted and the recommendation for Shelter NFI indicated that there was no need for response;
- **Yuai, Uror (Jonglei) – PAH:** PAH is present in this location and is carrying out a registration of IDPs arrived from Pajut;

Upper Nile:

- **Manyo County (Upper Nile) – DRC, WVI, and Caritas:** distribution continues as pending due to security;
- **Melut (Upper Nile) – World Vision:** 1,364 HHs are registered, exercise is ongoing;
- **Malakal POC (Upper Nile) – Medair and DRC:** The relocation to the new PoC extension continues, and registration/verification is ongoing. Tents to accommodate new arrivals are pending security clearance to be sent by air to the POC;

Unity:

- **Bentiu PoC (Unity) – PAH, Concern Worldwide:** assessment of NFI needs of both new arrivals and original residents of the POC is ongoing; Concern has constructed 7,700 shelter skeletons to date, and 5,500 robust shelter kits have been distributed to people relocating to their new shelters;

Central Equatoria:

- **Don Bosco (Central Equatoria) – Medair:** PDM is planned and will take place soon.
- **UN House (Central Equatoria) – IOM, LCED:** The distribution of Shelter reinforcement kits completed; 4,056 households across the POCs and some vulnerable cases in POC3 received in the response.
- **Mundri East and West (Western Equatoria) – ALDI:** Assessment completed and identified 2032 families in need;

Lakes:

- **Rumbek (Lakes) – PLAN, IOM, Sign of Hope:** Partners distributed to 259 HHs in Jiir and Matangai Payams. The distribution in Jiir was interrupted due to security.
