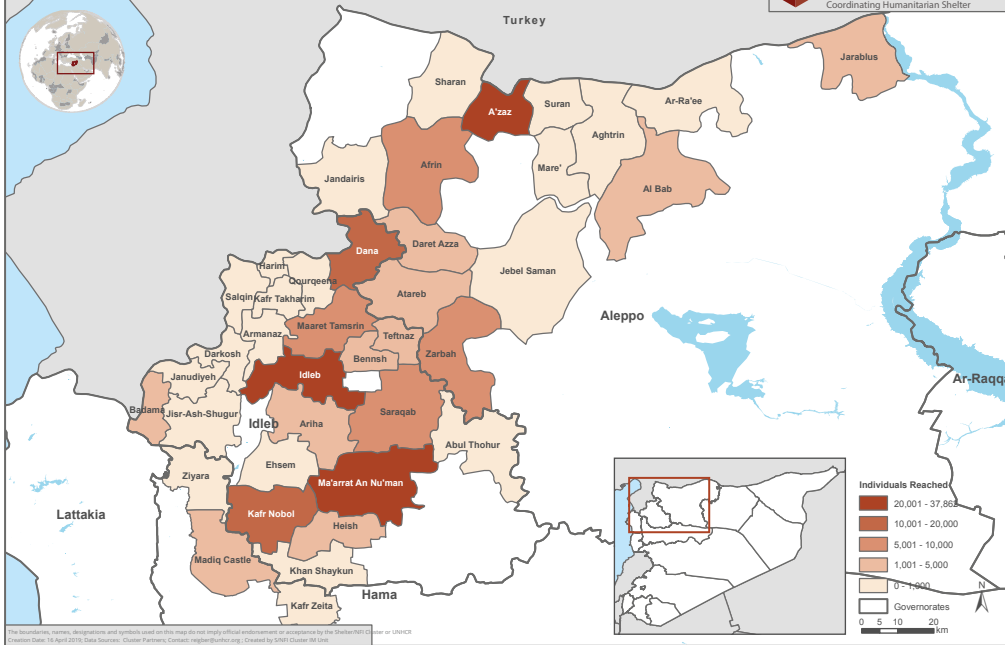


Shelter/NFI Cluster - X-Border Operations: Partner Coverage by Sub-District Turkey Hub - Gaziantep - March 2019



The Shelter and NFIs Cluster, led by UNHCR, coordinates the efforts of 143 total member organizations of which 50 are active. The Cluster addresses the coordination of emergency Shelter and NFI needs and promotes household and community resilience. The Cluster supports people in need within displaced, hosting and non-displaced populations by ensuring that the different modalities of interventions (in-kind, non-conditional/conditional cash or voucher) abide by the do-not-harm principle.

Highlights

Cluster Info

- The Cluster coordinated the response to newly displaced people in southern Idlib and northern Hama and responded to Contingency Stock requests in regards to these displacements.
- The X-Border Operation - Turkey Hub section on the Global Shelter Cluster website was re-structured and updated.
- The REACH SNFI Sector Assessment 2018 was finalized and all products were published on the X-Border Operation - Turkey Hub section on the Global Shelter Cluster website and shared with the Cluster Members.
- The CCCM & SNFI Cluster conducted a Joint – Technical Workshop on Shelter Space Availability Reporting in order to update the online dashboard which will feed into the updates of the NW Readiness Plan and the general preparedness of the Clusters.
- An Action Plan based on the Cluster Coordination Performance Monitoring - Survey was shared with the Global Shelter Cluster and WoS.
- The Cluster Coordination Team worked with the Review Board for the Contingency Stock on updating the guidelines and requirements for applicants to the stock.
- The Cluster visited the IOM Burc Warehouse to discuss NFI Kit content, current specifications of the items and quality feedback in order to update the Cluster's Guidance Note on Shelter and NFIs Kit Response as of 2019.
- Due to heavy rains over the weekend (30 & 31 March) a large number of sites are affected by floods and the CCCM and SNFI Cluster in collaboration with their Members were coordinating the immediate response.
- A one pager overview Factsheet for 2018 was developed.

Winterization

- The Cluster continued the coordination of Winterization 2018/2019 during March to finalize the implementation of the winter response.
- Winterization 2018/19 updates for the Turkey Hub were shared with WoS.

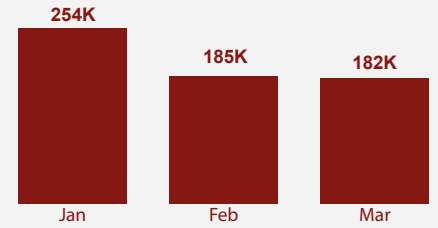
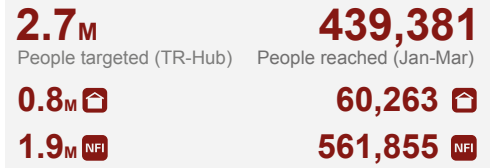
Cluster Priorities

- Preparedness for possible emergencies in NW Syria.

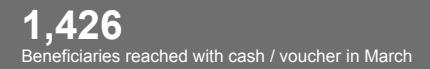
Challenges/Gaps

Key progress indicators



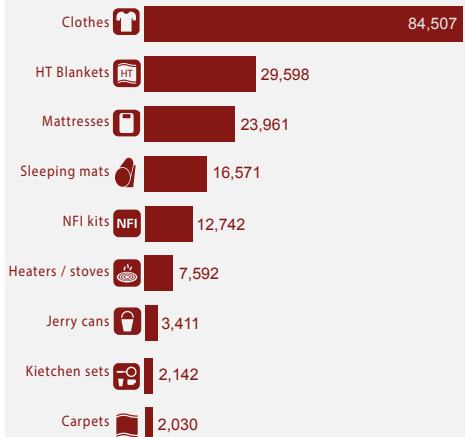
People reached from Turkey hub in March 2019
