Introductions

Review and approval of the minutes from the previous meeting of the 25th November.

1. Update on items being undertaken at Manila level:

Multi Sector Inter Agency Rapid Assessment (MIRA) 2 is due to be undertaken by OCHA, however, Shelter Cluster has it’s own detailed Shelter and Wash assessment being undertaken by REACH team. Interim results to be made available prior to finalisation of Agencies OPS submissions.

Cash Working Group still meeting, and emergency market mapping assessments being undertaken as part of this.

NHA directive is currently being discussed which calls for all permanent houses to be designed for Typhoon Category 5 winds.

2. Update on DSWD, NHA, Provincial Governments Plans

- Agencies can access DSWD Household roster which clarifies who is the most poor, by going to the DSWD at Municipality level. DSWD has agreed this information can be made available to agencies
