1. Introduction

The Shelter Cluster meeting will be held now every week on Friday 2PM, and will be chaired by PSWD and sub chaired by DSWD.

XG has just arrived in Cebu and will reinforce timely support to the Shelter Cluster (SC) for Region VII

2. Updates from Shelter Cluster

PSWD presented the LGUs report on assessments and shelter activities reported to date (Annex A of the minutes).

XG presented general updates on Shelter Cluster coordination at country level (Annex B to the minutes):

2.1 SC coordination national actual structure

2.2 The Damage Loss and Needs Assessments (DALA), led by NEDA is planned to be completed on December 12, to support the Yolanda Recovery and Reconstruction Plan development. SC has deployed 2 of the 4 experts (XG and Leonilo Escala from Habitat for Humanity) to support the process for the Shelter and Housing sector.

2.3 The IASC Strategic Response Plan is on consolidation process, which will lead to the revised appeal. There is 3 SC objectives:

- **Cluster objective 1A:** Shelter Cluster partners will provide **immediate emergency shelter and NFI solutions for households** in order to minimize the risk of GBV and decrease the rates of morbidity and mortality.
- **Cluster objective 2A:** Shelter Cluster partners will provide **support for household self-recovery through incremental housing solutions using consultative, participatory processes**

that respects diversity and the different needs of women and men of different ages, and prioritizing the poorest households.

- **Cluster objective 3A:** Shelter Cluster partners will provide **support to build community-level capacity to rebuild or repair housing damaged by the typhoon** including alternative supplies of materials, increasing labor supply, and ensuring appropriate access to building areas is available.

2.4 Country Response Progress (as 2 December):

Emergency Shelter: 34,000 emergency shelter delivered. Total planned = 484,000 HH

Self-recovery Support: Almost 30,000 HH supported. 94,000 funded / in the pipeline

3. Information Management - 4W of shelter Need/Gap

- LGUs could not have good access to internet, and then it limited their capacity to feed on SC website and reporting. Would it be possible to have reporting through an “offline package”.
- Barangay level of reporting is really important for LGUs
- SC Information Management System and products would really help LGUs to compare with information they could access in their area.
- Participants found the maps of gaps and 4W are really good tool to better understand the situation

Action During next meeting the SC coordination support team to present more in depth the Information Management system, and an updated situation of SC response in Cebu province.

LGUS, DSWD and LGUs present are really interested to know more about SC standards, to be able to better assess support delivered. XG presented the SC website platform and Technical guidance already developed. All participants agreed to discuss around standards during next meeting.
