1. DSWD updates for Governmental assistance

On Shelter Kits Distribution

On 200,000 CGIs in stock, 24 barangays left. Focus in Tanauan and in Palo next week. Distributions are following DSWD guidelines. 10 to 20 sheets by households depending on needs. Targeting Households and not families, for people who get house before Yolanda. No distribution would be made on No Dwelling Zone. Call for agencies to support by providing trainings on building Back Safer in area targeted by DSWD, and potential top up with agencies structural or other materials.

When current 200,000 CGIs will be distributed, 1 Million more will be distributed, when procured by DPWH. Importance for agencies to report through 3W usual format for DSWD to check on gaps to be covered.

Yollanda Recovery Shelter guidelines

Shelter Cluster Team drafting initial framework document, to be presented at informal SAG in Manila today Will be object of a workshop in coming weeks in Tacloban. Will outline Recovery Shelter Options (Shelter Cluster objective 2): Principles / Parameters - Temporary vs permanent location

Attendants really interested but think that costing realistic range and standards need to be emphasis.

Yes it will be part of it, and guidelines will be workshopped by membership to consider current activities but also ones which might be implemented.

3. Shelter Cluster prioritization tool.

What this tool is and is not: This is a beneficiary prioritisation tool. It is not a household assessment or a needs assessment tool. It is not a tool for selecting communities and it does not replace community consultation processes.

How to use this tool: Ideally the information you have already collected in your assessment process should be fed into this prioritization tool.
