District Shelter Focal Points

- Coordination at the district level amongst agencies implementing shelter activities and the Chief District Officer and other relevant local authorities.
- Terms of Reference
 - Focal point role
 - Support provided to focal point
- Process of identifying focal points – top three preferences

 - Ensuring emergency needs are met (monsoons and winter)
 - Support safer self recovery and self built temporary solutions.

- Cash for transitional support

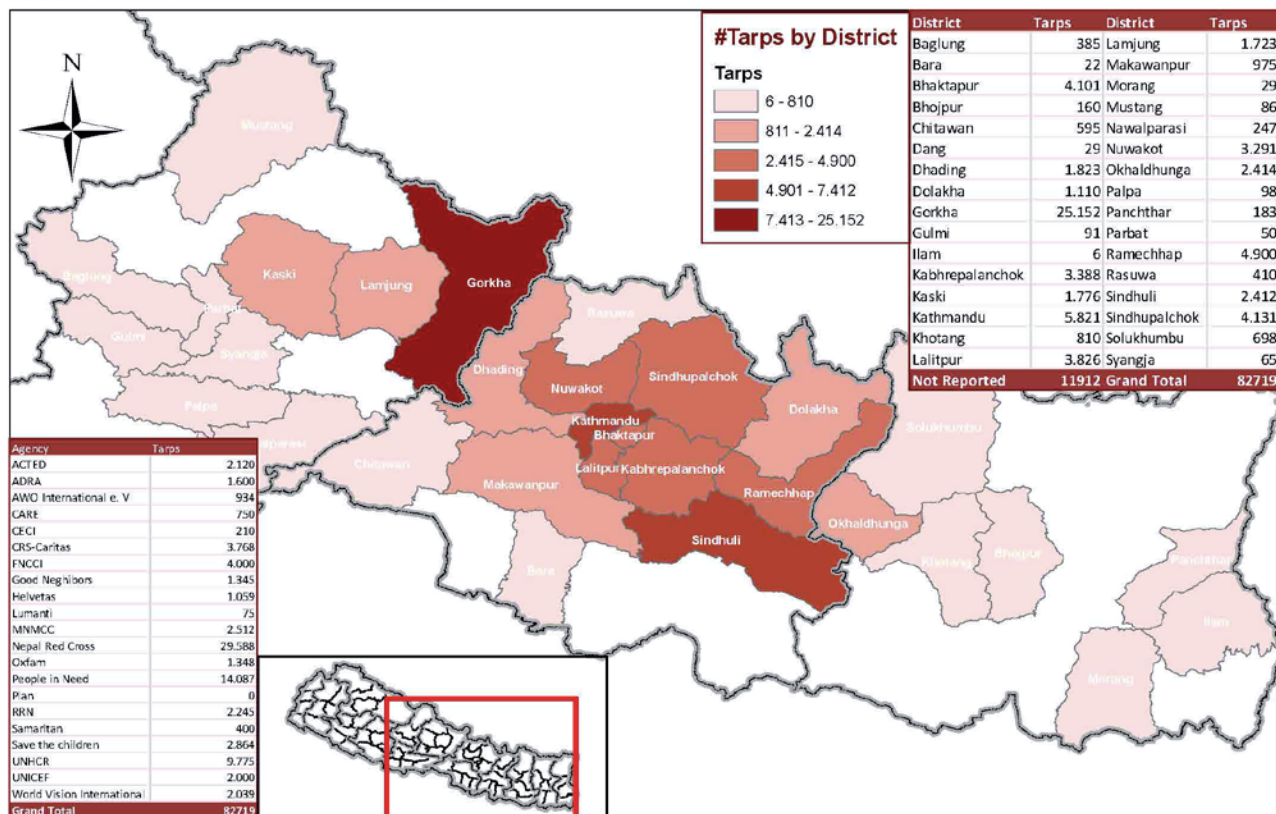


Information Management

■ Next Steps:

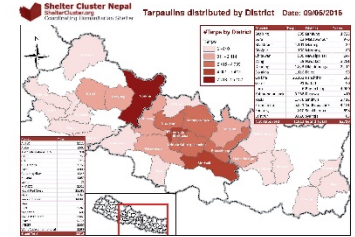
- VDC disaggregation: understanding how well the needs of hard-to-reach groups are met
- HH kits not reported: included blanket as standalone item.
- Recovery activities tracking:
 - Products: CGI, Repair tool kits
 - Cash: modalities (vouchers, grants), ranges.
 - Training

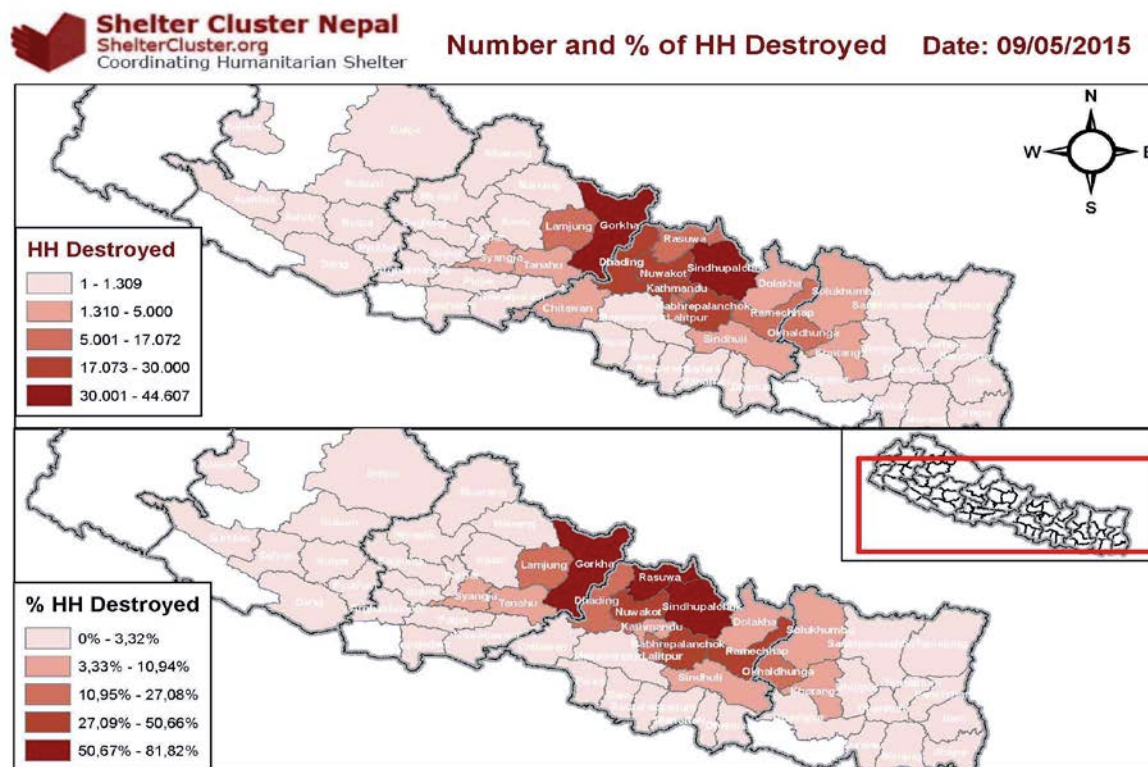
Information Management 2.2

- Mapping
 - Now: 3W at district level, tarps distributed.
 - Coming: 3W VDC level, HH Damage, Gap location, ...
- Analysis – Findings
 - Rasuwa: district under covered.
 - 8 Agencies and only 412 tarps distributed.



Information Management 2.3

- Number of HH destroyed is lower than %
 - Dhading
 - Kathmandu
 - Bhaktapur
- Number of HH destroyed is higher than %
 - Rasuwa



Shelter & Settlements Vulnerability Assessment

- Underway - A total of 120 household samples per district will be collected = 1680 households. Information will be collected by ODK to reduce human error
- A minimum of 10 households will be conducted per VDC allowing for 12 VDCs to be assessed per district
- By the 25th of May, the Shelter Cluster in support by the REACH Initiative country shall provide deliverables for 14 districts across the affected areas included in the initial assessment.
