### 3. Updates:

#### a) Flood response / DFID kits

- Save the children has distributed the 4023 kits in Korahe and Shebelle zone in Somali region
- Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC) is ready to transport and distribute 8,284 ES NFI kits to the Sitti, Faafan and Ngob areas of Somali region. NRC has requested additional funding from the EHF and is expecting to get the approval in the coming days.
- NDRMC has positioned 6.242 NFI kits in Afar, 6.072 In SNNP and 5.085 in Oromia regional warehouses. These kits are waiting for further distribution. 1500 Hygiene kits and 1800 water filters are waiting for distribution from Adama warehouse to the regions
  - Flood Response – SNNPR – Concern is writing an ECHO proposal for response in Welaita zone.

#### b) Update response in Somali – Oromia border region

- Hararge: Conflict: ERCS reported that 9,676 HHs have been displaced in Kumbi and has responded. IRC planning to provide 2.000 kits to the Kumbi Conflict.
- Liben zone conflict: 982 HHs displaced in Deka siftu woreda An Intercluster rapid assesment is planned in second week July in Hudat and filtu woredas of Liban
- IOM has started the distribution of ESNFI and dignity kits to 1,178hhs in Babile Woreda in Somali region
- Floods in Adama: 1,624 were displaced and on the request of DPPB, ERCS has provided ES/NFI kits to 300HHs
- IOM is mapping out areas to identify the different causes of displacement in the two regions and the responses.
- IOM is attending the DRMTWG meeting in Oromia d.d. 12-07. IOM has shared that NDRM has positioned their DFID kits in the region for floods response.

#### c) HRD Revision

- Revised HRD document has been shared with the clusters. Amount requested was revised from the initial \$7.4 million to 23,3 million.
- Strategy for requested amount:
  - Total target population will remain at 150.000 HH but the sector wants to preposition an additional 25.000 kits. An additional 91.000 will have to be procured



- Kits were defined as in the original HRD for \$50 but revised to 125 dollars (shelter + dignity Kits) based on the latest quotations and change of contents of the kits
  - DTM will continue
  - 3 new activities are proposed: 1) Strengthening regional coordination, 2) an EMMA- Emergency Market Assessment to prepare for potential Cash based programs 3) Technical research of the types of shelter construction in Ethiopia -> cause of damage + development of guidance on how to rebuilt/repair the shelter.
- d) AWD outbreak – Addis Ababa
- Health cluster confirmed that there were 2,386 confirmed AWD cases and three deaths so far.
  - ES/NFI requests for jerry cans and buckets are expected from the Health the cluster.
  - AWD is spreading out to the outskirts of Addis.
  - **AP: Cluster will share the latest AWD situation update from Health cluster.**
- e) IDP Task force: **Corrected input!**
- The intercluster IDP taskforce is led by UNHCR protection cluster and IOM ES/NFI cluster to ensure services are provided to IDP's in Ethiopia.
  - For this the Taskforce has finalized a TOR and will hold a workshop with **all the cluster coordinators** on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> of July. ESNFI cluster will keep agencies updated.
- f) Food & Non Food Task force
- With the establishment of the NDRMC as counterpart of the ES/NFI cluster, the intention is to integrate the ES – NFI cluster meetings in the Food & Non food Taskforce meetings co led by NDRMC, IOM (for Non Food) and WFP (for Food)
  - The ESNFI cluster coordinator will attend the Food Taskforce meeting on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July to discuss and plan this integration.
- g) LA Nina Forecast
- OCHA made a **DRAFT presentation** on LA Nina risks and vulnerabilities. It is forecasted that there will be extreme floods in 2016 followed by drought.
  - The presentation also helps to advocate to donors and highlight additional drought caseload. Paper copy has been shared during the meeting
- 4) Funding and needs Overview
- Funding and stock overview of the clusters has been compiled and shared.
  - The cluster has secured funding for ES NFI / dignity kits for approximately 80,000 HH and intends to procure an additional 90,000 full kits.
  - The ESNFI is analyzing and forecasting the needs for ES NFI response, using the DTM (2014 – 2016), the Belg assessment, and the Belg and Meher contingency plans. Forecast will be shared in due time.
  - Cluster Coordinator will present the ESNFI cluster responses and needs to the donor community on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> of July. In addition to that the cluster team will work on a fundraising plan for 2016 and can provide support (mapping, endorsing, giving input) to agencies that are raising funds.
- 5) Regional ES/NFI focal Points



- Agencies to look at the suggested table of regional FPs and comment. The cluster at the regions will have the same type of approach as the Branch office level coordination. But in areas where IOM doesn't have a presence, other cluster member will be approached to represent the ES NFI cluster.
- 6) ES/NFI kits specification
- IOM conducted market research of NFIs with twenty suppliers. The collected prices range from 87 dollars to 150 dollars. Samples have been requested from the suppliers in order to assess the quality of the items. Once assessed ES/NFI cluster members have the option to either use the IOM pipeline services (procurement and / or storage and / or distribution). The combined approach can improve efficiency and effectiveness of the NFI pipeline.
- 7) Information Management : 4W Matrix
- A mid-term review report is requested by the government and is expected to be launched on the 30<sup>th</sup> of July. Therefore all agencies are requested to share with the cluster updates on their activities and funds spent on a Woreda level. Cluster has sent a spreadsheet for this purpose along the agenda of this meeting.
- 8. AOB**
- International disaster Celebration led by NDRMC is planned to be conducted in October.
  - Cluster needs to see how they can participate in this event.
