Technical Assistance is highly needed in Camps for shelter upgrading

UNHCR & IOM says: More than 150,000 Rohingya refugees are in places at risk of landslides and floods, in what could become a disaster on top of the current emergency. *(source: <http://www.unhcr.org/news/press>)*

- Most of the emergency shelters are at risk from the flood, cyclone and landslides – High need of upgrading of shelters
- ISCG Says 78% out of 180,000 HHs already received upgrading shelter kits

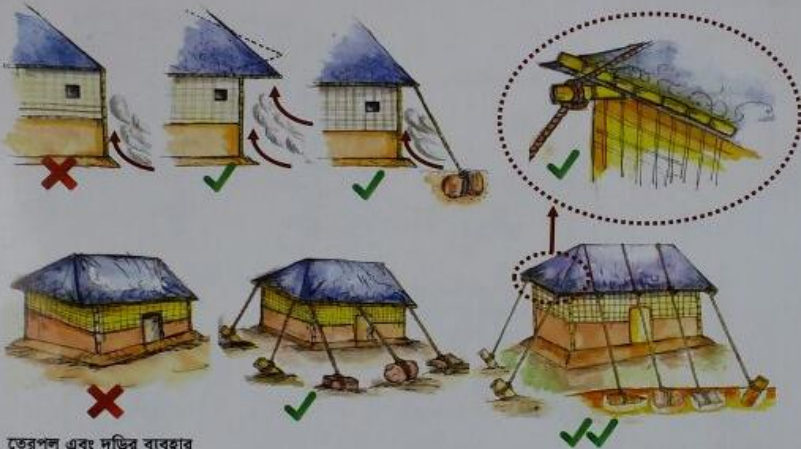
Main Activities:

- 1. Distribution of Materials;** Emergency Shelter Kits/ Upgrading shelter kits (ESKs/ USK)
- 2. Capacity Development on safer construction:** Mobilised beneficiaries to establish infrastructures, site development and settlement improvement. **On the Job Training (OJT) for** beneficiaries in close supervision of SCI Engineers
- 3. Construction of Model houses:** Providing support to families with Extremely Vulnerable Individuals (EVIs) for house construction which also worked as model shelters.
- 4. Awareness raising on safer construction:** Uses of IEC materials - how to fix plastic sheets and bamboos.
- 5. Technical orientations:** House to house visit, orientation during meeting, messaging through Majhis.

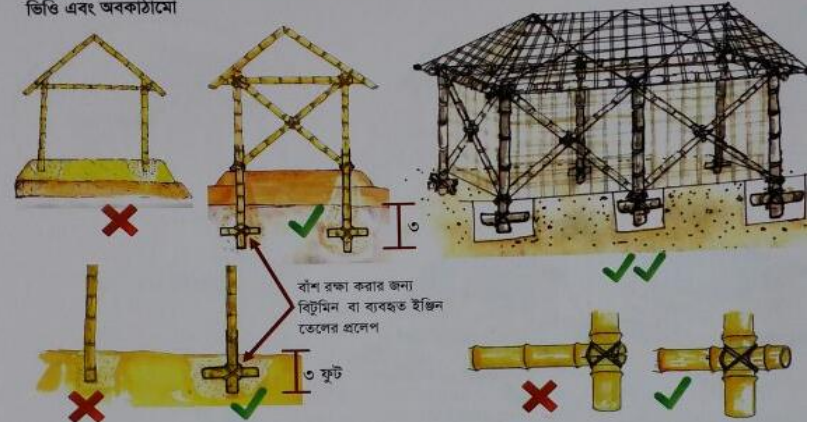

Major outputs:

- **Distribution of Emergency Shelter Kits (ESK) for 5000 HHs (UNHCR 2500HHs, and other from own funding)**
- **Distribution of Upgrading Shelter Kits (USK) for 11K HHs (under distribution: various donors and pipeline IOM)**
- **Establishment of 200 infrastructures like Child Friendly Spaces, Temporary Learning Centres (TLCs), Distribution Centres, Health clinic and community buildings - Daily wages supported to buy additional materials, fuel and cooking stoves. – mobilising 700+ construction workers in daily basis**

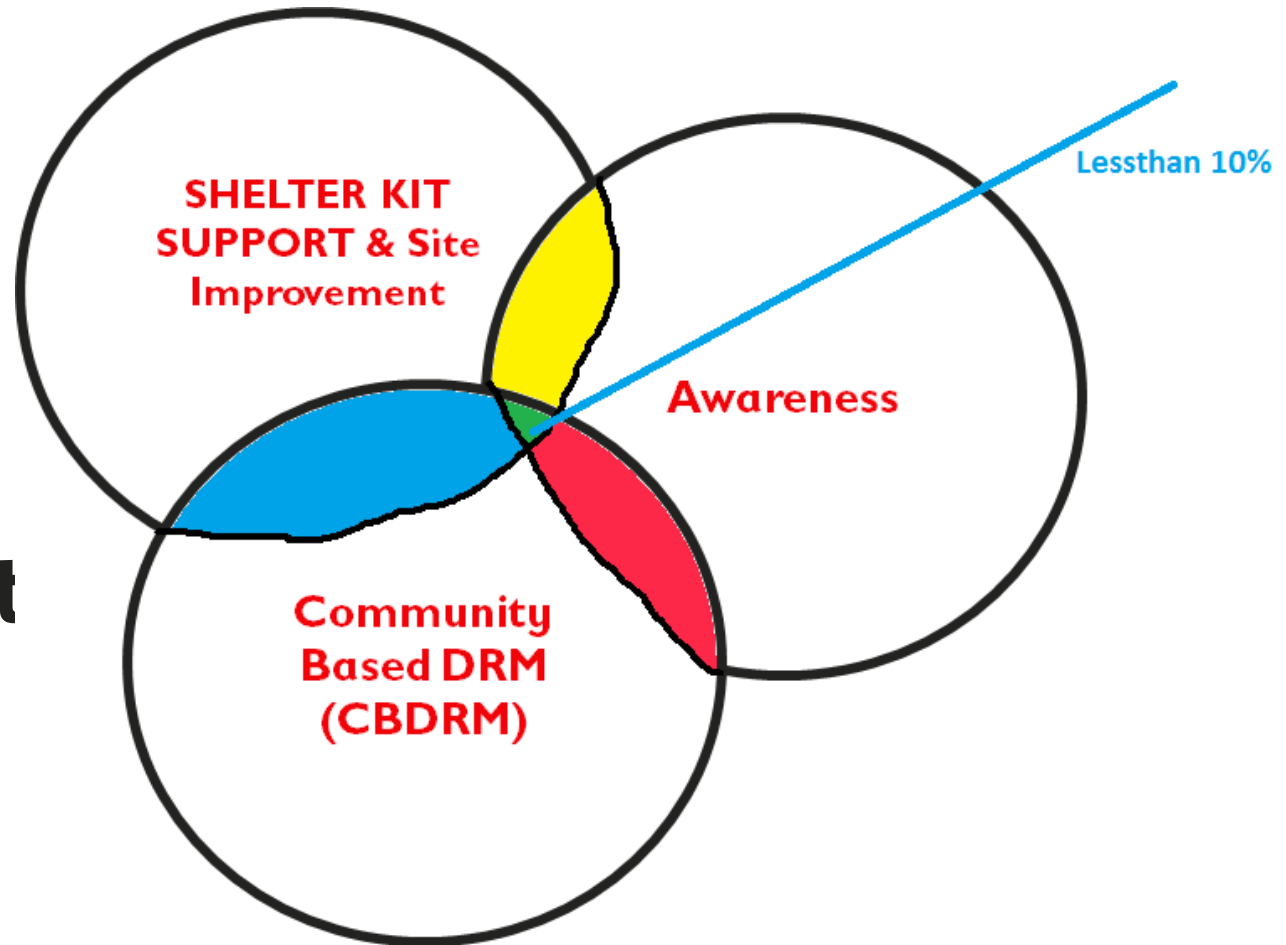







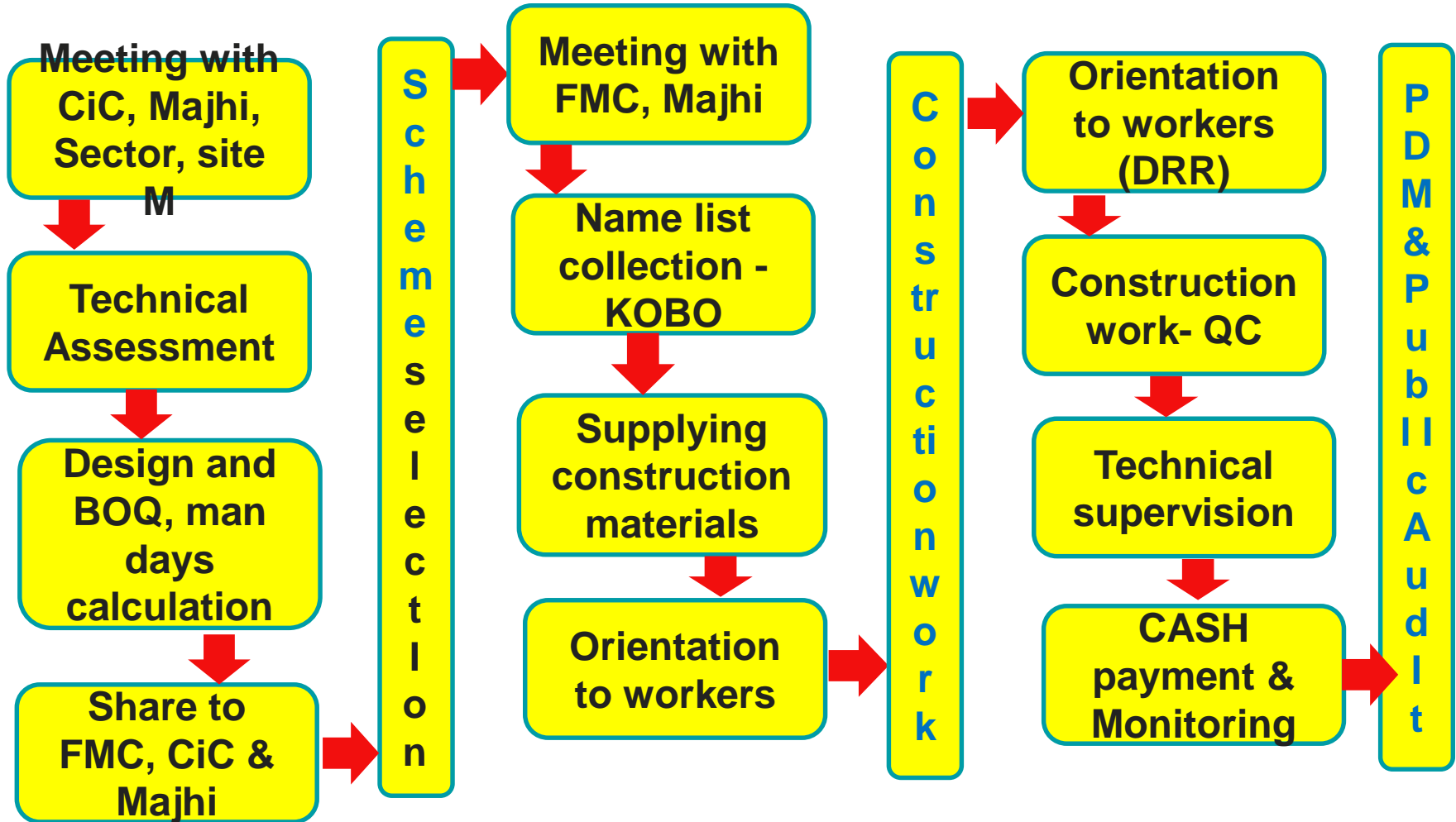

Learnings:

- 1. Mobilisation of host communities : to disseminate messages, to train beneficiaries to fix plastic sheet and CFW activities**
- 2. Beneficiaries need additional support.** Mobilising host and targeted communities for developing infrastructures are the good option. It is helpful to local market to inject cash, to host communities to increase cohesiveness and to beneficiaries to meet additional requirements.
- 3. Mobilisation of local materials, local people and local technology is easily adoptable.**

Technical assistance to complement NFIs for shelter

Challenges:

- 1. Difficulties to ensure high level of community engagement. Only Majhis, religious leaders and teachers are involving in the process.**
- 2. Language Barriers: English to Bangla to Burmese**
- 3. Scattered settlements.**
- 4. Difficulties to prepare disaster preparedness and response plan (DPRP) – contingency plan - communities**
