

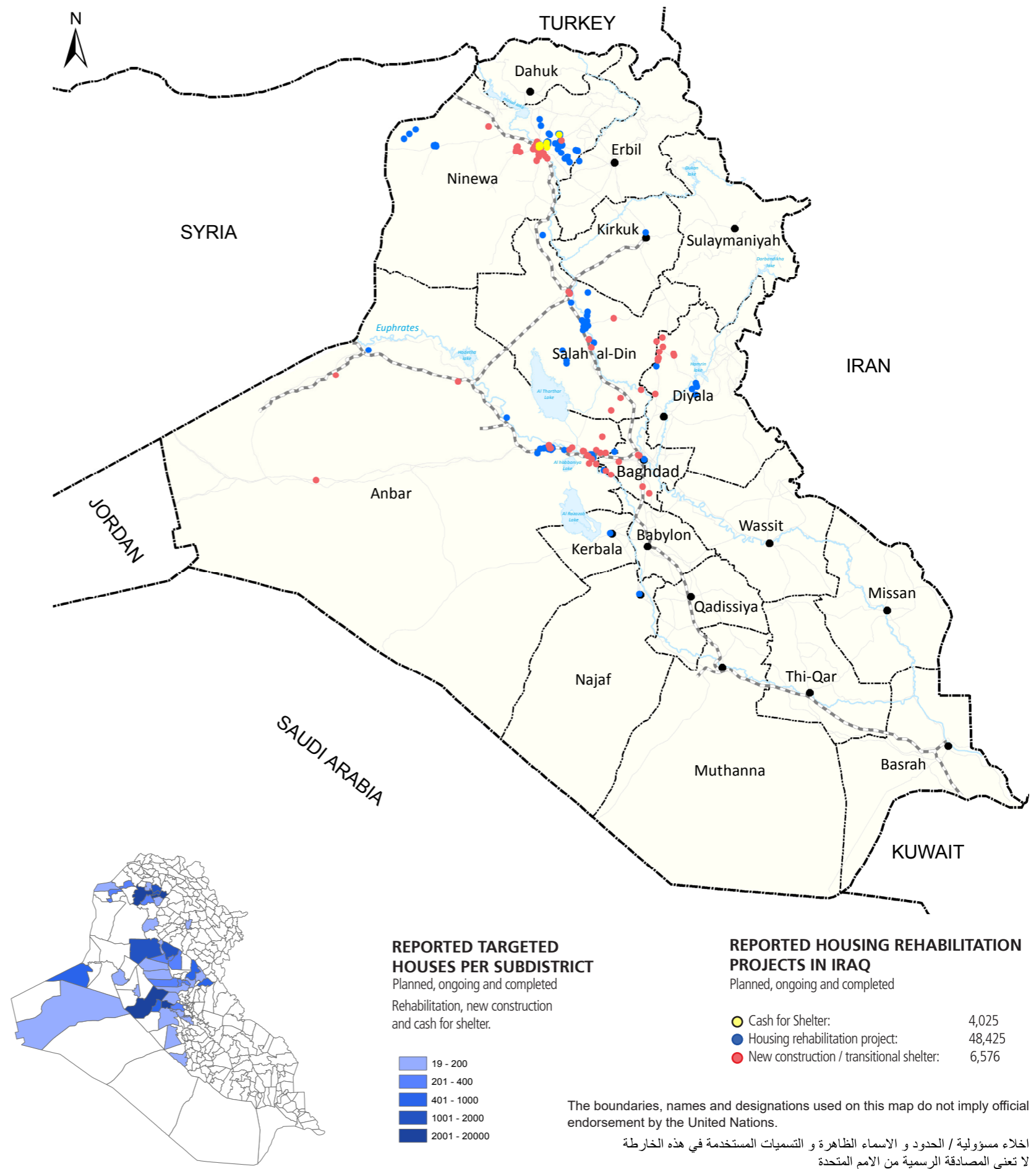
This overview, compiled by UN-Habitat and the Shelter Cluster, includes all reported rehabilitation, new construction/transitional shelter and cash for shelter projects in Iraq, up to July 2018. Rehabilitations make up 82% of all the projects, while new construction/transitional shelter makes up 11% and Cash for Shelter 7%. This overview shows planned, ongoing and completed interventions.

Around 38% of these projects are planned, 24% are still ongoing and 30% are completed.

This overview shows that the governorate with the most rehabilitation projects is Anbar governorate with more than 28,000 houses, half of which is already completed. Initial satellite damage assessments (Ministry of Planning & UN-Habitat in January 2018) suggested that the distribution of damage between governorate is approximately: Ninewa 65% / Anbar 20% / Salah al Din 10% / Diyala, Baghdad, Kirkuk 5%. currently, 40% of projects are in Ninewa, with a significant amount of these projects in the planning phase.

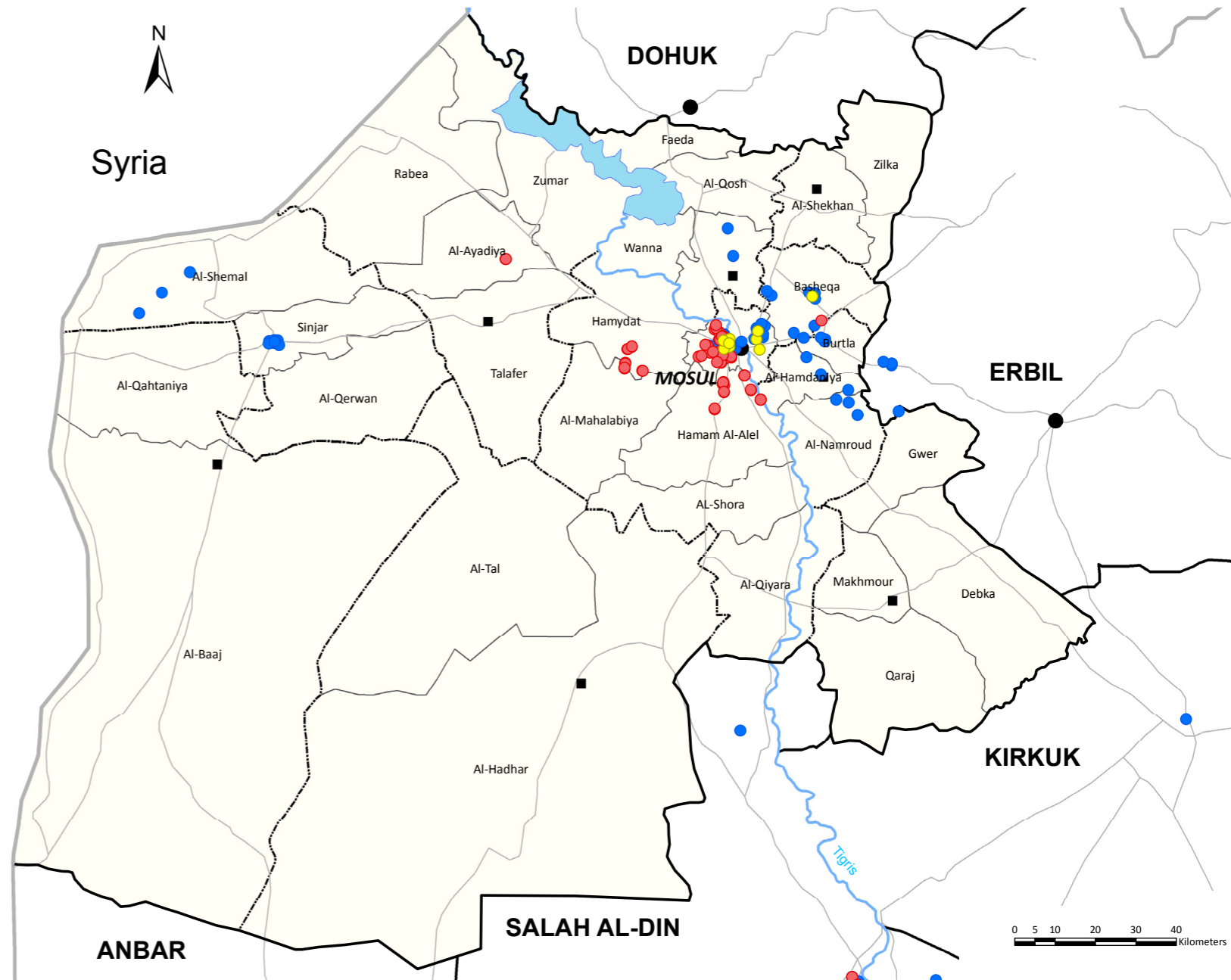
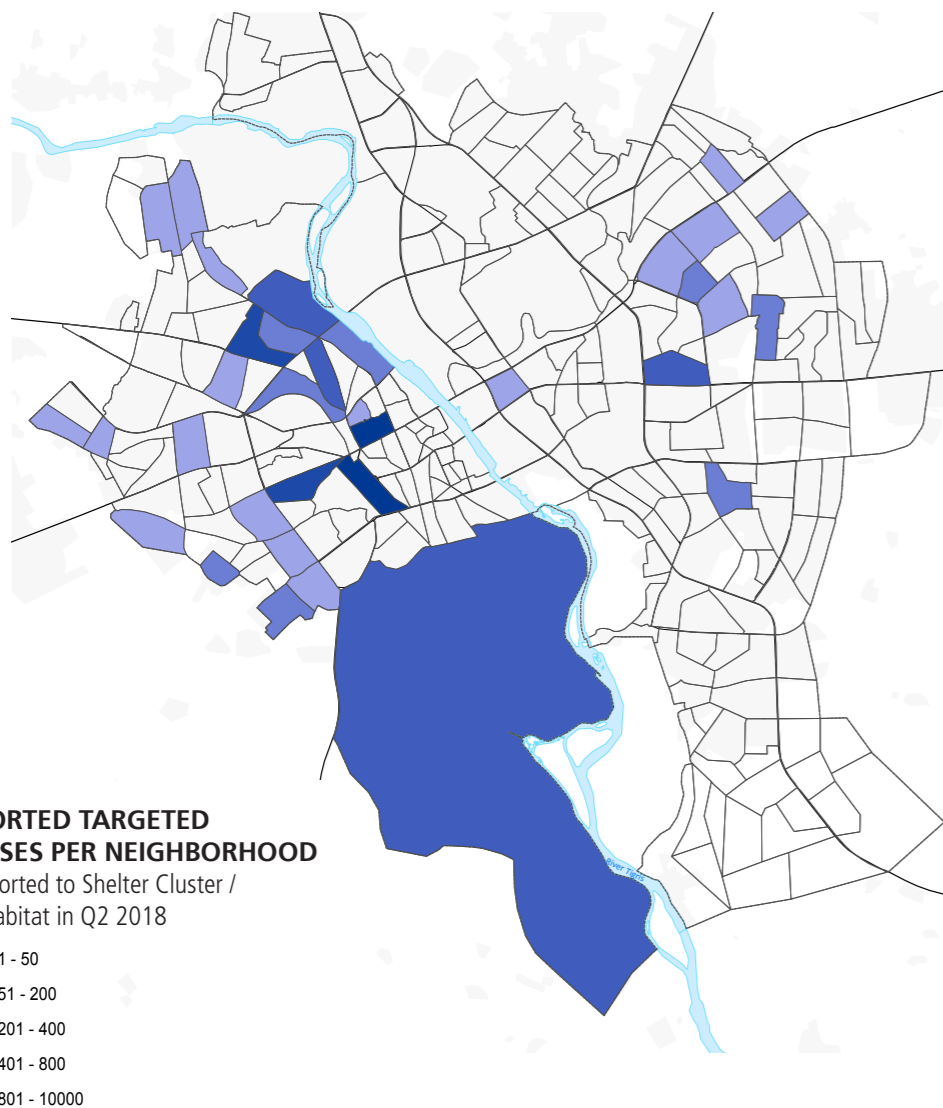
This overview of Ninewa shows that there are still gaps of housing rehabilitation projects in Telafer, with only 150 reported housing units selected for rehabilitation.

Around 66% of rehabilitation projects in Ninewa are planned, 9% are ongoing and 25% are completed.

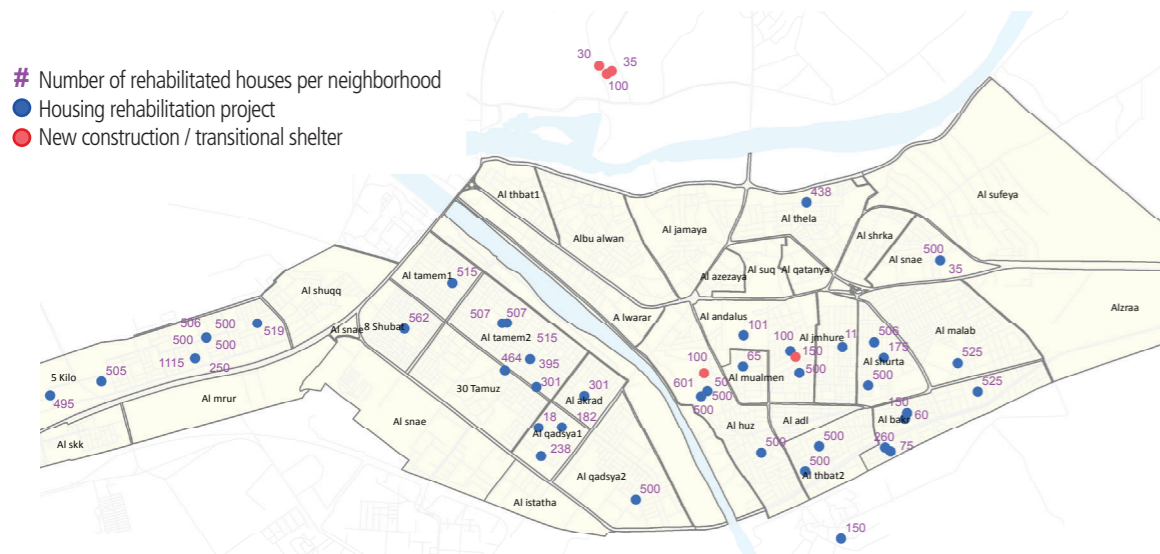
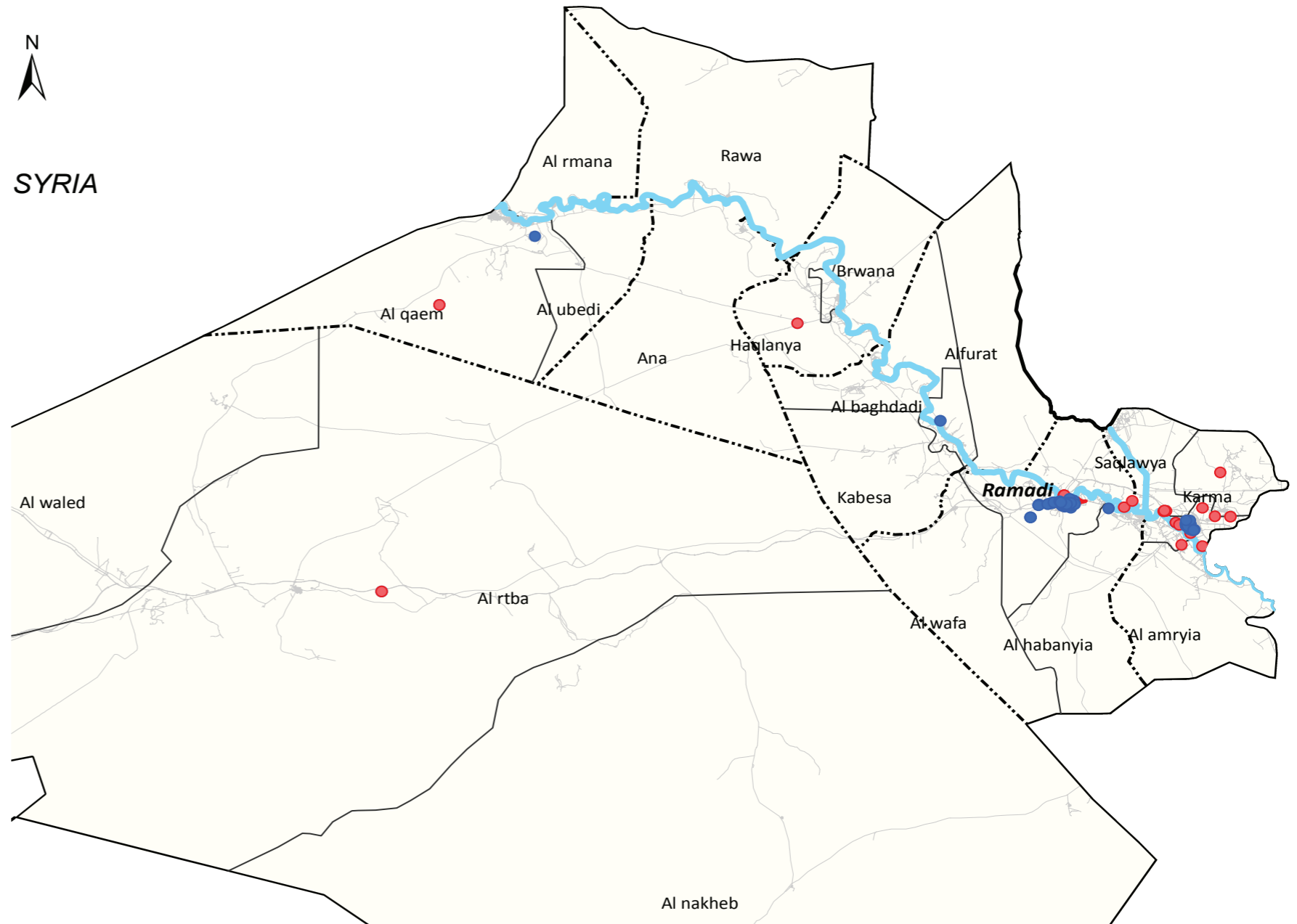
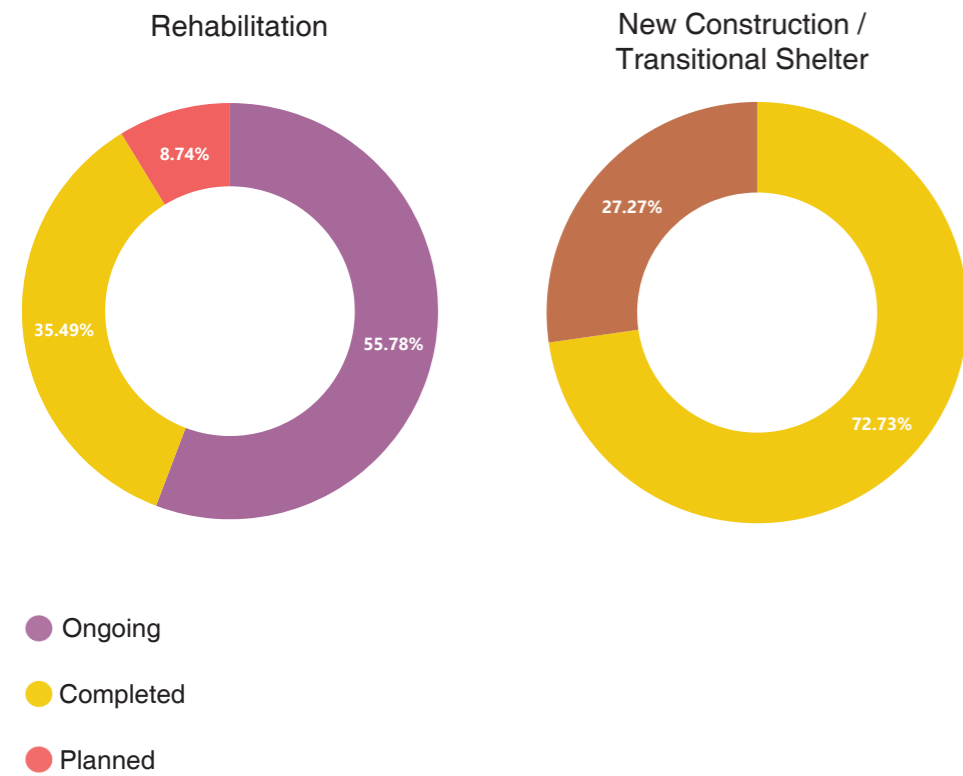

This overview of Anbar governorate shows that while almost half of all rehabilitation efforts are completed, there seems to be some gaps in rehabilitation projects in Khaidiya and Heet, because they make up 30% of the total damage in Anbar, while only 14% of the rehabilitation effort was directed to these districts.
