Revision of the Shelter/ NFI 2019 HRP framework

- Revision of the sectorial objectives compared to the strategic shelter cluster objectives and agreement on the proposal of an amendment
- Revision of the indicators linked to the sectorial objectives. Agreement on the proposal of an amendment and new inclusions
- Revision of the activities and indicators compared those included in the Shelter Cluster Strategy. Agreement on the proposal of an amendment and new inclusions

The agreed formulation of the is defined in the final framework that is attached with these minutes.

Explanation of the rationale for the target calculation followed in Yaounde by the Shelter/ NFIs technical working group.

- Revision of the % used for the estimation of the Population in Need as well as the targets estimated based only on the needs, the existing capacity and the access.
- **For the SW**, 70% of the PIN it was considered quite high, considering the access; the new proposal from the SAG is **40% of the PIN**
- **For the NW**, 60% of the PIN it was considered quite high, considering the access; the new proposal form the SAG is **35% of the PIN**
- For the **Littoral and West** regions, **80%; the SAG agrees on this one**
- For the specific target per activities it will be considered the % agreed on the intervention matrix in the SC strategy

Revision of the severity needs maps

- It was observed one division in the NW was completely white, potential mistake
- Agreed the inclusion of the IDPs living in bush as another indicator for this map in order to increase the level of detail.
