

NEEDS ANALYSIS:

- ✓ Instability during the first quarter of the year has made the situation unpredictable. Due to an increase in the number of displaced persons, the cluster has reassessed its estimate of people in need from 326,000 (in November 2018) to 351,000. Cluster partners reported that shelter is one of the key constraints for IDPs' integration with host communities.
- ✓ People in protracted displacement due to the growing insecurity across the northern regions tend to be the most vulnerable, because they lost their shelter and livelihood. The photos above illustrate that their shelters are either impacted by wind or by lack of maintenance due to the lack of resources to afford rehabilitation. These populations also lack access to NFIs.

RESPONSE:

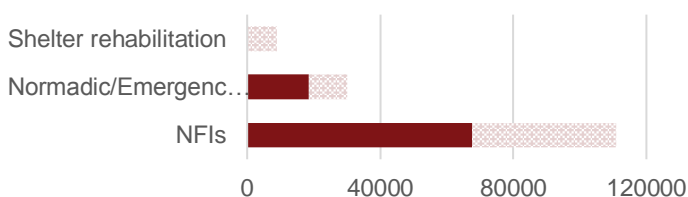
Following the HCT Strategy, the Shelter Cluster will focus on responding to the most vulnerable affected population, mainly persons with specific needs. For 2019, the Shelter Cluster aims to provide shelter support for 39,000 people and NFI assistance to 111,000 persons.

Cluster partners are targeting NFIs for vulnerable people in areas of conflict or displacement. Permanent shelters for house owners in return, nomadic shelters supported with construction materials or tool kits or with cash and the voucher assistance (CVA).

Gaps

Challenging humanitarian access and lack of relevant quantitative and qualitative assessment on shelter has limited assistance and targeting. The most significant gap is the gap in shelter rehabilitation. While the Cluster has largely been focused on response to emergency needs, the affected population is still in need of transitional and longer-term rehabilitation of their shelters. More partners and activities are required to response to this critical need.
