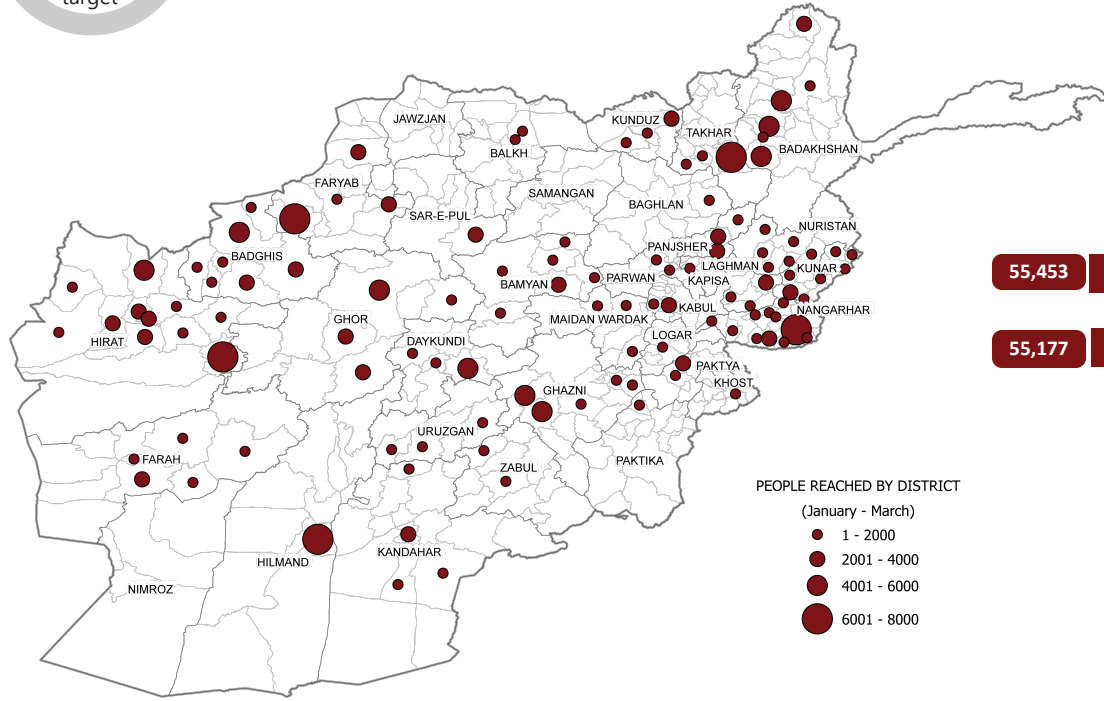


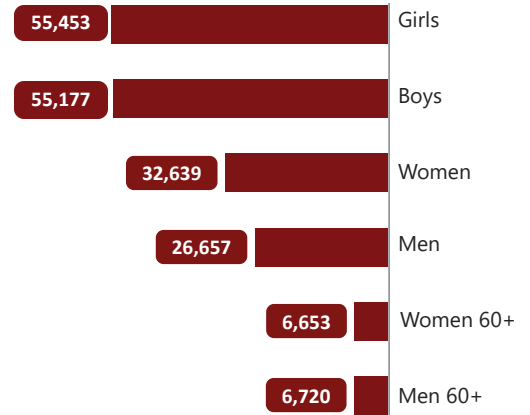

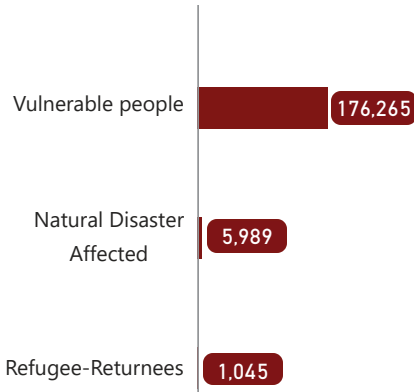


AGE & GENDER BREAKDOWN
52% of the population reached are women and girls, 60% are children



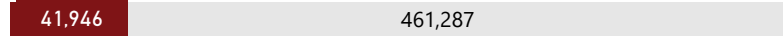

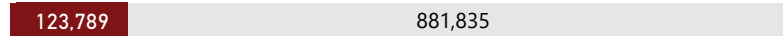

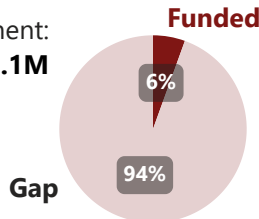
