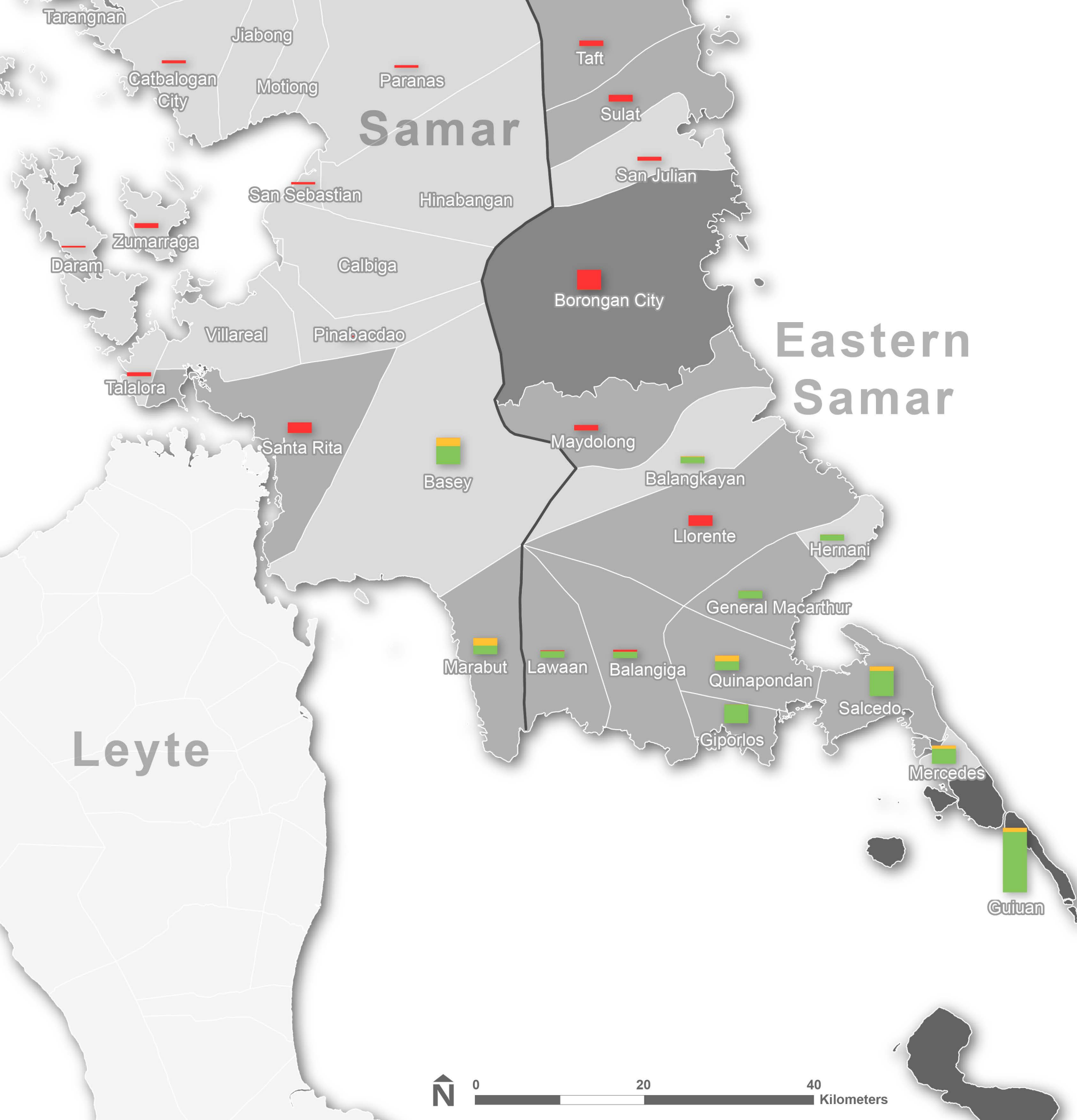


Emergency Shelter in Region VIII (Samar)
